After completing a master plan in 2001 and another in 2009, EUA has worked with Milwaukee World Festival Inc. on multiple projects including the north, mid and and south gates, the BMO Harris Bank Pavilion with a 10,000 fan capacity, Briggs & Stratton Big Backyard stage, Miller Lite Oasis, Uline stage, Summerfest Store, enhancments to the AmFam Amphitheater, updated bar areas and improved sight lines for better brand visibility and concert goer viewing. EUA's transformative design maintains an elevated image on the festival grounds, keeping it fresh and relevant for an enjoyable experience for festival goers.
