The City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) plans to use the Ebola virus disease (EVD) supplemental funding for active monitoring (AM) and direct active monitoring (DAM) activities to enhance capabilities for electronic DAM and ensure local reporting, and to develop plans for persons that are lost to follow up or noncompliant.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

This program supports the Health Department's strategic objectives to reduce illness and injury from communicable disease and improve outbreak response and investigation.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

These funds are need to ensure that recent travelers from Ebola-affected counties and individuals at-risk for EVD are regularly monitored for symptoms, improve overall response to emerging infectious disease.
