## **MOTION**

I move that the Substitute Ordinance of Council File 060075 be amended at page 3 by deleting subsection 4 which reads:

- "4. VEHICLES CONSTITUTING A PUBLIC NUISANCE; ABATEMENT. a. A motor vehicle operated 2 or more times in an unlawful assembly is declared to constitute a public nuisance.
- b. Upon conviction of a motor vehicle operator for 2 or more violations of sub. 3-a involving the same motor vehicle, the city attorney is authorized to initiate proceedings in abatement of such nuisance vehicle and to seek appropriate relief including, but not limited to, removal and sale of the vehicle."

This motion leaves the penalties in place for unlawful assembly and unlawful assemblies involving vehicles. The motion removes the language that authorizes the city attorney to seek the removal or sale of vehicles.
