As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Wis. Stat. § 895.35, Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

This claim is being submitted under §895.35(2), STATS., which provides that:

Notwithstanding sub (1), the City . . . shall reimburse a protective services officer for reasonable attorney fees incurred by the officer in connection with a criminal proceeding arising from the officer's conduct in the performance of official duties, unless, in relation to that conduct, any of the following applies:

- a. The officer is convicted of a crime;
- b. The officer's employment is terminated for cause;
- c. The officer resigned for reasons other than retirement before the attorneys fees are incurred;
- d. The officer is demoted or reduced in rank
- e. The officer is suspended without pay for 10 of more working days. §895.35(2), STATS.

Officer Post is considered a "protective services officer" under the statute. He has incurred the fees compiled in this claim as a direct result of his being investigated for actions taken within his official capacity, and in the performance of his duties, in connection with the use of deadly force. None of the "exceptions" apply¹.

¹ The officer was not convicted of a crime, terminated for cause, resigned prior to incurring the fees associated with this claim, demoted, or suspended without pay for more than 10 days. See 895.35(2)(b), STATS.

The incident resulted in the District Attorney's Office conducting a criminal investigation into the shooting of Mr. Larry T. Ellis, under Chapter 979, STATS. That investigation qualifies as a "proceeding" which mandates payment under 895.35(2), STATS.

Attached is a copy of District Attorney Chisholm's letter dated January 26, 2007 confirming that Officer Post's actions were privileged and in self-defense.

On October 23, 2006, Milwaukee Police Officer Gary Post shot and killed citizen Larry T. Ellis (d.o.b. 12-11-1980) after Ellis charged at him with a knife and ignored commands to drop the knife, in the area of 966 N. 35th Street in Milwaukee.

Former Chief Deputy District Attorney Robert Donohoo and I conducted a thorough investigation of this matter, and I have concluded my review as it relates to the actions of Officer Post. I am satisfied that Officer Post committed no crime and his actions were privileged by self-defense under 939.48, Stats.

I have communicated my findings to the family of Larry T. Ellis through Chicago attorney Steve Muslin and the decedent's mother, Ms. Beryldene Williams.

This office is continuing to examine the circumstances under which the decedent, Larry T. Ellis, was released from mental health custody. The ongoing investigation, while substantive in nature, has no bearing on the actions taken by Officer Post.

By this letter, I respectfully request that Officer Post be allowed to returned to full duty.
