Hello Mr. Askin,

I'm writing to you regarding the permit number listed in the subject heading. We received BOZA approval to place this building 4 feet from the rear lot line. Please reference BZZA-20-00241. Our architect did note this on the plans, but he drew the building with a rear setback of 6 feet. We do plan to build at a 4 foot setback. There are two NEW garages directly to the north of this address that are built at a 4' setback. We also have deemed there to be plenty of space to maneuver vehicles in and out of the garage. I am hoping to clear up any ambivalence in the plans and the other documentation by informing you here of our intentions. Please write back to confirm your receipt of this information. I am hoping this is simply a formality and a show of respect for your position. If you do have an issue with a 4' setback, please call as we are planning to excavate within a few days.
