There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Mr. Morton and Ald. Davis, (and everyone else!)

OK, so as I stated I would, I went to Always Towing to inquire what was going on with these tows. Here is a break-down of what I found so far.

Please remember that the state law changed July 1st, 2014 that allows tow companies to remove vehicles from private property IF properly posted without a citation being issued.

- 1) Always Towing contracts with many different private properties throughout the City of Milwaukee. They do require a written contract with the property owner for the removal of unauthorized vehicles.
- 2) Some of their customers (landlords) do provide them with a list of authorized vehicles. This list is uploaded into their database so that they can check vehicles on private properties to the list for that location.
- 3) NOT ALL customers (landlords) provide a written list. Some properties use a permit system. If a vehicle, even a legal tenants vehicle does not display a permit, it gets towed. The permit-style properties do not always provide a written list to Always Towing. This might be something we should look at for part of a new ordinance??? Just a thought....mandatory lists.....
- 4) Always Towing does take pictures of the vehicles they tow prior to removing that vehicle.
- 5) _____ contracts with Always Towing for about 500 units (apartments) and uses a permit-style towing rule for his properties
- 6) Always Towing recommends to their customers (landlords) to issue a letter to all tenants instructing them on the law and what to do and what not to do. I am unaware if _____ does this to his properties as I haven't spoken to him yet.
- 7) Always Towing CONSTANTLY monitors the properties they contract with.

I am assuming the property on _____ properly posted, but I haven't been out there yet either. I also do not know for sure if _____ actually made notifications to his tenants.

I did look at the before pictures of _____ vehicle, parked in _____ on the apartment lot. Not sure if that is her regular assigned space. The pics were too dark to see if she had a _____ Permit.
I did look at her vehicle whilst in the lot at Always Towing. I did see a parking permit in the back window, HOWEVER, the permit was for a _____ ent, not _____ (peered through the glass onto the van floor and did not see it laying there, as it might have fallen off. I am told _____ has their own type of

permitted to see a parking permit office that had a sign on the car. Always Towing also provides customers with parking permits of their own.

I did observe that the vehicle was locked up tight. Always stated that they only tow cars to get a VIN if the VIN is covered and there are no plates.

I did notice that her plates were missing. When I inquired about the plates, there was no answer. I did physically get down on my hands and knees with some of their employees and went through hundreds of car tags to find hers, which we did. The owner was extremely mad at the employees for covering the plates and cutting them up when they were not supposed to. I got her car out, they will own her a new set of plates and registration, they say. And they said as well.

For as frustrating as this law is, I cannot see what they did wrong, and believe me, I'm all about catching businesses doing wrong. Yes, it does seem like a legal scam. Can we do emergency rules or ordinances like the state does??? I really don't know that's why I'm asking. And like I stated in my other emails, Always has been beat up so much that they keep pretty accurate records etc.

The permit argument can be made, but we deal with this same thing at the tow lot on a daily basis. Prove it was here, prove it wasn't. How many vehicles get towed by parking checkers and the person says "I had a permit," then you look at the car and there is no permit, but they do own a permit? Are these customers truly following the rules of the building owner? I am for sure not calling anyone a liar for the record, but what can we prove.

I have included my new boss, Sgt. Signuoli on this email to keep him up to speed. What do you all think about making a small media thing with the major news outlets telling the citizens about this law, what is expected what can happen?

I can tell you that the longer the car sits there, the more it is accruing storage fees that can top over \$1000 eventually. She will soon be getting a letter, certified, that states they have her car. 21 days after the sending of the letter, if she doesn't pay, **THE VEHICLE WILL LEGALLY BECOME THE PROPERTY OF ALWAYS TOWING** and they will dispose of it as they see fit. That is a state law mind you.

I realize this isn't what anyone wanted to hear, but I don't know what else to tell you. I did call [redacted] but haven't heard from her yet.

Dear Alderman Davis and Legal Aid Morton -

I called your office this afternoon on behalf of [redacted] W apartment 1 and talked to Mr. Morton. We believe that a scam is occurring at this property, whereby residents' cars are being removed without cause, held for a "ransom" of huge fees, with a possible kick-back to the property owner.

Mr. Morton asked how many cars have been affected [redacted] s collecting names of tenants, but estimates at least 20 cars in the last few weeks.

The property owner is [redacted] When approached b [redacted] about this situation, [redacted] aid he was too busy to talk to [redacted]

One tidbit I did not mention in our conversation. When asked by the towing company ("Always Towing") to prove that a tenancy sticker was in [redacted] car, [redacted] y provided a letter signed by the property manager. [redacted] l). The towing company responded by phoning [redacted] and threatening him, stating that he should not have signed this letter and that "tomorrow you might be out of a job". Interesting!

Officer Thiele, thank you for investigating.

I contend that the towing of my car on [redacted] was absolutely wrong and illegal, and that my car should be returned to me.

So, apparently it comes down to an issue of who to believe, i.e. "was the sticker there or wasn't it?"

To summarize:

Always Towing's "proof" that the sticker was NOT there consists of the word of its employees and a photo which is too dark. Please consider that the employees may have something to gain by stating that the sticker was NOT there. Perhaps they get paid for each tow, perhaps they're protecting each other, perhaps they're following orders, etc.

My proof that the sticker WAS there consists of a signed letter from our property manager, stating that he gave me a sticker and watched me properly affix it to the window. What would the property manager have to gain by telling an untruth? Nothing. In fact, he even may have jeopardized his job with this letter. He subsequently received a threatening phone call from Always Towing (which is not his employer!) saying that he "should not have signed that letter" and "tomorrow morning you might not have a job".

I would like to further discuss this situation with you. If you stop by my apartment, I will show you the signed letter from our building manager.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 4/6/2015 at 1:45 PM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

This report is written by P.O. Frank YINKO, District Three, Late Power Shift. The majority of the report is based on the original report of IR#143640001.

On 12-29-14, at 11:29pm, Squad 3465 (P.O. Michael FASULO and I) responded to 2624 W. Lisbon Ave. (Lisbon BP) to assist Squad 3482 (P.O. William KRUMNOW and P.O. Debora STACEY) with an arrest.

On 12-29-14, at 11:12pm, Squad 3482 responded to a Shotspotter at 1843 N 30th St. Upon arrival, Squad 3482 observed a vehicle leaving the same area at a high rate of speed. After several traffic violations, the same vehicle entered the parking lot of Lisbon BP (2624 W Lisbon Av).

P.O. KRUMNOW activated the red and blue lights and siren of his fully marked MPD squad car to conduct a traffic stop. The driver of the vehicle, later identified as Robert J. WILSON (b/m 12-31-94), stopped his vehicle directly in front of the gas station entrance, located on the south side of the premise, and exited his vehicle. P.O. KRUMNOW ordered WILSON "Stop Police, get back into your vehicle". WILSON disregarded my official order to stop and exited his vehicle. It appeared as though WILSON placed both of hands inside the front pocket on his hooded sweatshirt and near his waistband (based on his training and experience, WILSON'S actions were consistent with that of someone concealing or carrying a firearm). WILSON then quickly walked into the gas station. P.O. KRUMNOW immediately went to the side entrance/exit door located on the south side of the gas station and P.O. STACEY ran around to the north side entrance/exit of the gas station to prevent WILSON from exiting. P.O. STACEY looked into the gas station window and observed that WILSON was standing in front of the checkout counter. P.O. STACEY then observed WILSON walk back towards the exit on the south side of the gas station. P.O. STACEY then quickly walked around to the south side of the gas station where WILSON was attempting to exit the gas station. P.O. KRUMNOW then ordered WILSON to "stop" at which time WILSON attempted to try to get back into his vehicle. P.O. KRUMNOW and P.O. STACEY then placed WILSON into custody for resisting arrest.

P.O. STACEY walked into the gas station to check and see if WILSON may have discarded any contraband. P.O. STACEY walked into the gas station and smelled a strong odor of marijuana. P.O. STACEY then walked into the area of the gas station where she last observed WILSON standing (between the checkout counter and the food rack). P.O. STACEY observed two clear plastic sandwich bags, containing a green leafy substance, suspected marijuana, and one clear plastic bag containing an off white chunky substance, suspected cocaine, placed inside of a Munch peanut bar box.

P.O. FASULO and I observed WILSON discard an object into the same area on the premises' surveillance video.

At District Three, Squad 3460 P.O. SMITH, tested the off white chunky substance, which tested positive for cocaine base at 7.25 grams, placed on inventory#14046995 and the green leafy substance, suspected marijuana, which tested positive for THC at 23.16 grams, placed on inventory # 14046995. The narcotic packaging was placed on inventory#14046998 and was sent to Boff to be processed for possible fingerprints.

In the District Three booking room P.O. KRUMNOW seized \$4,264.50 from WILSON as drug proceeds. The monies were placed on inventory# 14047007.

Both the amount of narcotic drugs seized from WILSON, and the amount of monies (\$4,264.50), that was in his possession are consistent with that of street level sales.

A check of the Wisconsin Circuit Court revealed that WILSON has a prior narcotics conviction, case#14CM000682. WILSON is also currently on probation for possession of THC.
