**Description of work** Reconfigure existing, unpermitted projecting sign to match the following description: retain two round mounting posts, have dimensions of 96"H x 30"D (plus posts) x 6"W. Create painted border on north and south faces. Change existing letters to transparent push through letters. Pprojection of letters from surface of box shall not count in calculation of 6" width for

purposes of this approval.

Eliminate portion of wall sign at northeast corner of entry. Text facing east onto Old World

Third shall be eliminated. Text facing southward shall remain.




Present conditions. Projecting sign as existing is approximately 11" wide. Circled text facing street to be eliminated. Matching text on other side of column facing south may remain.
