This incident involved the investigation of a fight and subsequent arrest.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled POs Lelinski and Novak to give statements concerning the incident after issuing PI-21s. Later, the DA decided not to issue criminal charges against the officers. Attached is an itemization of the time and services rendered.
