Bridge over Union Pacific Railroad to West Lincoln Avenue

## Dear Honorable Members:

The Common Council has previously authorized and directed the Commissioner of Public Works to execute an agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WISDOT) for the programming and construction of street lighting on West Forest Home Avenue (STH 24), from South 31<sup>st</sup> Street to South 27<sup>th</sup> Street, and on South 27<sup>th</sup> Street (USH 41), from the bridge over the Union Pacific Railroad to West Lincoln Avenue in conjunction with paving using Federal/State Aid under the Surface Transportation Program.

The construction will include the installation of new street light facilities and removal of overhead facilities within the aforementioned project limit. Funding for the installation of the lighting would be available from WISDOT through a Service and Supply contract.

The attached resolution authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Public Works to execute a Service and Supply contract with WISDOT that allows City forces to install the lighting within the subject limits of West Forest Home Avenue (STH 24) and South 27<sup>th</sup> Street (USH 41) with Federal/State Aid under the Surface Transportation Program, which will cover 100 percent of the cost.
