While I fully acknowledge the importance of compliance with city regulations and appreciate the clarity provided in the violation notice regarding permissible branch lengths, I believe this fine has been issued in error.

Upon receiving the violation notice, I promptly addressed the issue by trimming the branches in question to ensure compliance with the city's regulations. This action was taken prior to any work performed by city-assigned personnel. I even approached the worker on-site to inquire about their presence and observed their activity. By the time their work was completed, the branches had already been trimmed to regulation length by me, resulting in no further action being necessary.

My immediate action to rectify the issue demonstrates my commitment to adhering to city regulations. Furthermore, the tree line in question provides vital privacy and security for my home, and the extensive trimming performed beyond my corrective measures has left my property unnecessarily exposed.
