
Dear City Clerk:

I am in receipt of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendations recommending non-renewal of the Food Dealer Retail license to my client, Jose L. Gonzalez, Agent for Carniceria El Indio, Inc., based on the police report and testimony given at the hearing of the Licenses Committee.

On behalf of my client, I am filing a written objection to the License Committee's decision. My client's objection is premised on the fact that a long-standing, trusted employee was involved in the alleged illegal conduct on the premises. That employee's employment has been terminated and he will no longer be involved in the grocery store business. Mr. Gonzalez's son testified at the hearing that he was now in charge of the grocery store business. Additionally, the grocery store has been in business for a considerable amount of time and has never been cited for any illegal activity.

With those points in mind, we ask the full Common Council to renew the food dealer retail license to Jose L. Gonzalez, Agent for Carniceria El Indio, Incorporated.
