The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DEPARTMENT) and the City of Milwaukee Fire Department (CITY) plan to partnership during the I-94 N-S Corridor Reconstruction Project (Project) to ensure that emergency response capabilities are not adversely affected by roadway construction.

Without Fire Department participation in roadway planning and incident mitigation efforts Milwaukee's emergency response capabilities would be adversely affected by roadway construction.
