## **Department of Public Works Comments**

Review for redevelopment of the property at 3205 South 27th Street as a parking lot

October 10, 2025

The applicant, St. Luke's Medical Center, is proposing to raze the existing office building at 3205 South 27<sup>th</sup> Street and construct an expansion to the parking lot present on part of the property at 2700 West Oklahoma Avenue. The parking lot expansion will include 26-spaces and be surrounded by a significant landscape buffer. Both properties, 3205 South 27<sup>th</sup> Street and 2700 West Oklahoma Avenue, are within the Aurora St. Luke's Medical Center Detailed Planned Development (DPD – Phase 1) and an amendment to the DPD is required to permit this work.

## Water

Water Review Comments for [St. Luke's Medical Center] [3205 S. 27<sup>th</sup> St. /2700 W. Oklahoma Av.]:

- MWW has an 8" water main in S. 27th St. available to serve the subject development.
- All proposed water service/branch abandonments, taps and installations to be reviewed and permitted by DNS Plan Exam (Milwaukee Development Center).
- Tapping means/methods would need to be coordinated with DNS Plan Exam (Milwaukee Development Center) during the permitting process.
- Any proposed bends in branch pipe would require additional review by DNS Plan Exam.

  - Caller should state "For planning purposes only-Milwaukee Water Works only need reply".

- Any proposed water mains or fire protection shown on the site will be private.
  - o Private hydrants are required to be metered.
  - o Metering can occur through a meter pit or in the building.
  - o Private hydrant should be connected to water system after the metering device.
- Milwaukee Department of Neighborhood Services Plan Exam (Milwaukee Development Center) reviews all private-side water inquiries and permit submittals.
  - Includes ?s related to water services, water branches, water meter pits/vaults, proposed water meter locations, private fire protection requirements, plumbing permits, etc.
  - o Includes coordination of tapping means/methods during the permitting process.

## **Environmental**

- Sanitary and Storm sewers are available in S. 27<sup>th</sup> St.
- Disturbance is for less than ½ acre, slight decrease in impervious surface area. Storm water management plan is not required for this development as long as
  - 1. The cumulative area of all land disturbing activity is less than one acre over a 3-year period.
  - 2. No additional impervious surface of 0.5 acre or more is added, and
  - 3. The cumulative area of all land disturbing activity is less than two acres
- No green infrastructure is required unless over 5,000 sf of impervious surface is added.

DPW has reviewed and provided comments for two permits for this development: COM-ALT-25-00449 & COM-ALT-25-00432.
