Subject: Honorary Street Name Request – “Alderman Terry L. Witkowski”  
West Norwich Street from South 6<sup>th</sup> Street to South 5<sup>th</sup> Place.

Dear Honorable Members:

This letter is in reply to an application dated February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024 regarding a request for an honorary street name of Alderman Terry L. Witkowski on West Norwich Street from South 6<sup>th</sup> Street to South 5<sup>th</sup> Place.

Chapter 113-3 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances provides the guidelines to consider when reviewing honorary street name requests. The guidelines provided in the code have been reviewed and the following comments are offered:


Terry L. Witkowski served as the 13<sup>th</sup> District Alderman from 2003-2019 and previously as Safety Director for the City of Milwaukee from 1986-2000. In 2019 he became Chair of the Garden District Neighborhood Association. He led the effort to develop unused space east of South 6<sup>th</sup> Street adjacent to Norwich Street into community gardens and public space for farmer’s market and various neighborhood events.

The request to honor Terry L. Witkowski with an honorary street name of “Alderman Terry L. Witkowski” includes 27 letters and spaces. The letter size of the honorary street name will be sized to fit the standard honorary street sign.

Two (2) blue honorary street signs will be needed. Please refer to the attached map showing where the honorary street name signs will be located. The petitioner may choose to furnish the honorary street signs, but they must be fabricated to established City standards. The City can fabricate the signs at \$50 each. In either case, the City will install the honorary street signs at a cost of \$50 per sign. The petitioner is to deposit \$100 to the City if they furnish the signs or \$200 if the City fabricates and installs the signs. If a sign needs to be replaced in the future, the City is to be notified of the missing or damaged sign and the petitioner is to cover the cost to fabricate and mount the sign as described above. The City’s cost to fabricate and install future signs is subject to change.

West Norwich Street will remain the official street name so addresses will not change.

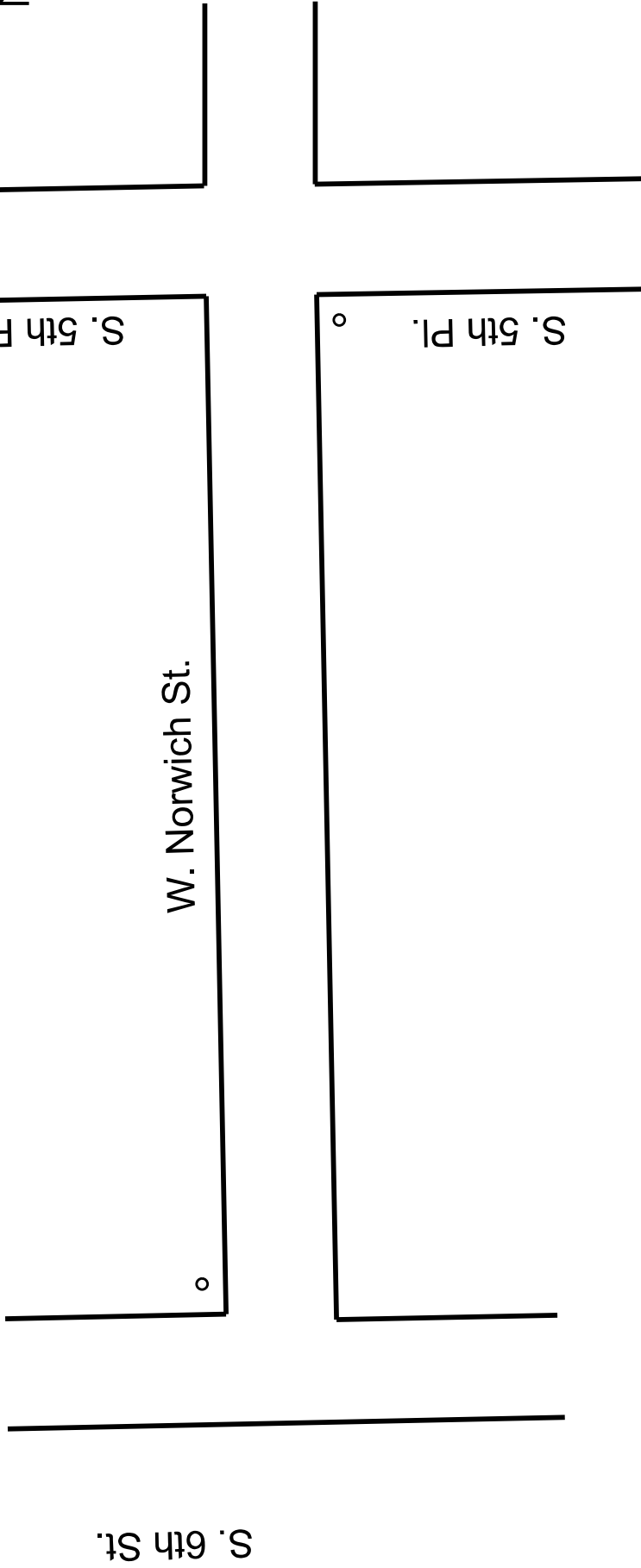
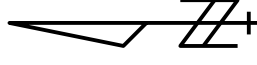
