Dear Attorney Corbett:

We have received the claim of your client, Alicia Meier, for the amount of \$50,000.00 in relation to the incident that occurred on January 8, 2013 at 807 East Linus Street.

The Milwaukee Police Department reports on January 8, 2013 squad 6131 was dispatched to a property pick up call at 807 East Linus Street. The responding officers were previously dispatched to this residence for prior domestic violence issues between Alicia Meier and Jerald Wehrli. Based on the previous incidents that occurred at this address, it was assumed that Ms. Meier and Mr. Wehrli lived together, and a separate address was not confirmed. The responding officers escorted Mr. Wehrli to the front of the residence and inside of the home to retrieve his personal items.

The police action taken in this matter was necessary and appropriate. Since the police were not negligent, and were acting within the sphere of their responsibility, the city would not be liable. Therefore, we are denying your claim.
