Your Class A Fermented Malt and Food Dealer Licenses Application as agent for "RP MART INC." for "EXPRESS STOP" at 3611 W VLIET St.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings during normal business hours is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of Kilbourn Avenue and Water Street. You must present a copy of the meeting notice to the parking cashier.

We've had to deal with, for 22 years, the constant noise, loud music at all hours, drug dealers on the west side of the building, shootings (I have a nice hole on the side of my home and inside from one of them)...maybe not selling liquor would help a bit. It would also be nice if they had to close by 10pm every night, along with the smoke shop open on the corner of 35th and Vliet, which is open much later than they were originally approved for if I'm remembering right, and they have not one but two sets of flood lights around their building; blackout curtains don't even help much- it's ridiculous.

I prefer not to give my last name or address as retaliation in the hood is a common occurrence.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 07/29/07 at 4:35am, officers investigated an armed robbery that occurred at 3611 W. Vliet St. (Fast Stop Food Market). The victim stated he drove to the gas station and parked at the pumps. He went to the window to pay for gas and buy a pack of cigarettes. While waiting for the attendant he was approached by a black male, who was armed with a gun. The suspect took the victim's money and vehicle.
- 2. On 12/07/2011 at 8:43pm Milwaukee police conducted a field interview of an individual in the parking lot at 3611 W. Vliet St. (Fast Stop Food Market). This interview was based on information Milwaukee police had received, anonymously, from a citizen regarding drug dealing and loitering at this location. This interview resulted in an arrest for Possession of Marijuana. Milwaukee police report #113410142 was filed.
- 3. On 08/16/2013 Milwaukee police made contact with the husband of the applicant at 1361 North 36<sup>th</sup>, this building is the same as 3611 West Vliet Street (Fast Stop Food Market). The officer left a copy of the municipal ordinance as it relates to secondhand dealers licenses.


#### ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

I spoke with Rajaminder Singhsangha, who was present during the CPTED assessment. Rajaminder stated that he is interested in purchasing the business from the current owner, Harvinder Singh. I discussed concerns regarding the current sale of items such as Chore Boy, metal tire gauges, and scales—all of which are commonly associated with drug use and drug dealing. Rajaminder stated that, if he were to purchase the business, he would not continue to sell these items. I also explained the Fusus program to Rajaminder, and he expressed interest in participating in the program.



The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 6/10/2025 at 2:10 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
