On Friday, February 14th, 2025, at approximately 8:55 pm, I, P.O. MEXICANO, while assigned to Squad 7421, with my partner P.O. BANDKOWSKI, were dispatched to the address of 9330 W Capitol Dr, which is Sunrise Liquor & Gifts, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI, regarding a theft complaint. We were wearing a full Milwaukee Police Officer uniform, including our department-issued badges and body-worn cameras.

Upon arrival, we observed that the establishment was closed for the day. We attempted to call the caller but could not get an answer. We looked through the establishment window and observed a night worker stocking the establishment shelf. We knocked on the establishment's door to try and get his attention, but he did not turn in our direction. We also flashed our flashlights at him, but we could not get his attention. Due to being unable to contact the caller or the night worker inside the establishment, we were unable to investigate the theft complaint.

This report is written by PO Vincent ANDRYSCZYK assigned to District 7, Day shift. On Thursday, April 17, 2025 at 11:09am, Squad 7132, PO Jose RAMIREZ and I were dispatched to 9330 W. Capitol Dr (Sunrise Liquor) regarding a theft complaint.

Upon arrival, I spoke to the caller, John B. GREEN, w/m, 09-25-81. GREEN stated that he is a semi truck driver for Holiday Wholesale and was making a delivery to 9330 W. Capitol Dr. GREEN stated on 04-17-25 at approximately 10:40am the semi was parked in the parking lot, on the east side of the business facing south. GREEN stated he was inside the store when an unknown subject approached the open door of the trailer and intentionally removed two green 2'x3' plastic shipping totes from inside the trailer. GREEN stated the totes typically contain cigarettes, but he was unsure of how many were obtained and the brand names. GREEN stated these actions were done to permanently deprive him and were done without consent. GREEN stated that Holiday Wholesale will contact me when they make a final determination of what was obtained. Holiday Wholesale is self insured.

I observed video surveillance from 9330 W Capitol Dr which depicts a black GMC SUV park in the alleyway behind the business on 04-17-25 at 10:37am. Video depicts a subject wearing all black clothing and an orange baseball cap, exit the front passenger side of the vehicle, run to the semi trailer and obtain two of the green totes and then back to the SUV. The vehicle then flees through the alleyway. Video surveillance further depicts the SUV circling the block around the business prior to stopping and stealing the items.

PO RAMIREZ downloaded the surveillance video and uploaded it onto evidence.com.

The business was cooperative with the investigation. The business had 0 security officers on scene.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date. I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
