This report is written by Police Officer Carlos Felix, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- 1. On 01/11/25, at 11:48 PM., an officer responded to 3510 N. 7th Street, Clark Gas, to conduct a License Premise check. The employees on scene were advised of the inspection. One employee called an unknown person who identified themselves as the agent. The person (agent) on the phone would not verify their identity and became argumentative, refusing to cooperate with the officer's investigation. Employees on scene, also became argumentative causing the officer not to proceed with the inspection attempting to diffuse the situation. The business was highly uncooperative during this contact with an officer.
- 2. On 03/03/25, at 6:00 PM., officers were dispatched to 3510 N. 7th Street, Clark Gas, for a Stolen Auto complaint. Officers were able to recover a stolen auto that was abandoned near a gas pump. The employee on scene just started their shift, and did not have any information regarding the vehicle, nor did they have access to the security cameras. No business violations observed.

On Monday, March 3, 2025, at approximately 6:00 PM, I was dispatched to the location of 3510 N 7th St. in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI for a stolen auto recovery.

Upon arrival, I found a white Dodge Durango, bearing Wisconsin registration AKH8562 parked near a gas pump # 5 (Clark Gas Station). After checking with MPD databases, P.O. LINDSEY discovered that the vehicle had been reported stolen.

I inspected the vehicle for valuables and people, and the vehicle was clear. There was no damage, P.O. LINDSEY attempted two times to contact the owner of the vehicle at approximately 6:25 PM, identified as Dominique S. JONES (B/F 1-1-1990), and didn't get an answer. I attempted one more call at approximately 6:45 PM, JONES answered the call and stated she would attempt to pick up her vehicle; however, she was advised that if the tow truck arrives before her that her vehicle will be towed to the Tow Lot located at 3811 W. Lincoln Av.

P.O. LINDSEY took seventeen (17) digital photographs of the vehicle at 6:54 PM.

Tow # 2519808. All City towing arrived on scene at 7:06 PM and towed the vehicle.

Officers made contact with a worker in the gas station who stated that the vehicle was there when he arrived to work earlier that day. He stated he did not know what time the vehicle was got to the gas station. The worker also stated that he did not have access to the cameras. All license information was up to date.

This report was written by Police Officer Kimberly L PETTERSEN, assigned to District 5, Late Power Shift (Squad 5468).

On Saturday, January 11th, 2025, at approximately 11:48 PM, I went to the address of 3510 N. 7th St., located in the City and County of Milwaukee (WI), to conduct a license premise check. This location is a Clark gas station.

I arrived on scene at approximately 11:48 PM, in a marked Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) vehicle and in full duty uniform. I was equipped with my MPD issued Axon Body Worn camera, which was activated during portions of this investigation.

Upon entering the gas station, I observed two clerks behind the front counter. I asked how the clerks were doing and walked towards the door that leads behind the front counter. I believed that the door would have been locked and when I pulled on the handle, it was open. I entered and introduced myself and gave the reason why I was at this location.

I informed the clerks that I would be checking the permits to make sure that all were up to date, that I had a few questions regarding the gas station, and that I would be checking miscellaneous items on the shelves that were placed out for purchase to make sure there were no expired items.

One of the clerks stated that he needed to call his boss and requested a card with my information on it. I advised the clerk that I was going to provide a contact card with him at the end of my investigation, and the clerk requested it immediately. I filled out a Community Contact Card and handed it to the clerk.

The clerk and the male subject, who allegedly was his boss, exchanged words via cellphone, and the clerk gave me a thumbs up as if everything was fine and that his boss would call me. I advised the clerk that I needed to ask some information regarding this location because I was going to be filing a report.

The clerk handed me his cellphone and I began to speak with his boss. I introduced myself and explained that I was going to different gas stations/bars, making sure that all permits were up to date, ask a few questions, and check the shelves to make sure there was no expired food out for sale for the public.

I asked the male subject if he was the agent of this location and the male subject stated yes. As I asked the male subject for his last name, he interrupted me and asked me why I was at this location at this time of night and why I could not come during the day. I advised the male subject that I do not work during the day. After I explained that I do not work during the day, the male subject stated that he was **NOT** going to cooperate with me.

I explained to the male subject that it was fine that he did not want to cooperate with me, however my interaction with him would be entered into a report. The male subject stated that this was ridiculous and that at midnight I was going to wake someone up. I explained to the male subject that I did not ask for his clerk to contact him and the male subject interrupted me once again, stating that the police never come when they need us at this location. The male subject stated that they call the police all the time and never come, but at midnight, I wake him up to bother him.

The male subject kept interrupting me and I informed him that it was my turn to talk, and that there was no need to get hostile or display an attitude with me. The male subject stated that he was going to make a complaint against me and I advised him that I did not know what he was going to file a complaint against me for. I stated to the male subject again that this interaction was all going to go into a report that I would be filing.

The male subject stated that I should not be coming in without permission, and as I was stating that I do not need permission to enter the store, the male subject stated that I did not have permission to go behind the front counter. I advised the male subject that his clerk let me behind the counter and the male subject stated that I should have let his clerk call him first before entering behind the front counter. The male subject advised me that I should leave from the location and I advised the male subject that I would be contacting additional individuals regarding this incident and that I was going to have his location shut down.

I informed the clerk that he was being ridiculous and that I came in with a polite manner, and came over to speak with both clerks. The clerk stated that he needed to call the boss and I explained to the clerk that I did not have him call the boss and that he called his boss on his own. The clerk stated that I never asked to come behind the front counter and that I should have asked. I informed the clerk that I came behind the front counter so that I could speak with both of them.

I left from behind the front counter to stop engaging with the clerks, because the one that I primarily spoke with, was becoming boisterous with me and overly loud at times. I removed myself from the situation and exited the location.

EVERYONE THAT I SPOKE WITH AT THIS LOCATION WAS HIGHLY UNCOOPERATIVE, ESPECIALLY THE MALE SUBJECT, WHO VERBALLY IDENTIFIED HIMSELF AS THE AGENT

Before my negative interaction, I was able to view the permits which were posted behind the front counter.

The permits that were posted were:

- Extended Hours Establishment Issued date of 04-09-24 & expiration date of 04-08-25
- Filling Station Issued date of 05-08-24 & expiration date of 05-07-25
- Cigarette and Tobacco Issued date of 04-09-24 & expiration date of 04-08-25
- Weights & Measures Issued date of 04-09-24 & expiration date of 04-08-25
- Food Dealer Retail Issued date of 05-08-24 & expiration date of 05-07-25

I tried to verify these permits on the Milwaukee City License Search website, however I kept receiving a message that this website was currently unavailable.

I never was able to get the agents name, which who I was speaking with via cellphone, but the name of the agent listed on the permit that I could see, was Mohammed KHAN. I did not enter KHAN as the agent in this report because as I was speaking with him, I was never able to verify his information with him. I did not obtain either clerks information during this interaction due to the negativity and uncooperativeness of both of the clerks.

I will be referring this incident to the CPU Division for further investigation. This interaction with the clerks/agent was all captured on my MPD issued Axon Body Worn camera.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.) 6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
