Your Class A Fermented Malt and Food Dealer Licenses Application as agent for "NFS1 LLC" for "FREEDOM GROCERY" at 2909 N HOLTON St.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings during normal business hours is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of Kilbourn Avenue and Water Street. You must present a copy of the meeting notice to the parking cashier.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

- > Per the business owner, the building has been vacant for approximately two years. The business owner is remodeling the building.
- > The building is currently not equipped with a surveillance camera system, but the business owner plans to install interior and exterior surveillance cameras once he receives his business licenses.
- The building does not have a drop-safe, but the business owner plans to place a 500 pound safe inside of the building once he receives his business licenses.
- > The business owner plans to sell tobacco products, malt alcoholic beverages, and convince store food products.
- > Recommendations: Add exterior lights on the North side of the building near the alley that runs East and West to minimize concealment areas. Also place exterior surveillance cameras on the North side of the building.

- > Observations: There was a black junction box located in the basement's West storage area that contained faulty wiring. There was an abundance of loose wires that appeared to be a fire hazard.
- > Observations: There was a large sticky glue rat trap, located on the basement floor of the West storage area. It was recommended that the business owner have a licensed pest control company to inspect the building for rodents.




City Concentration Map for 2909 N Holton ST Milwaukee
