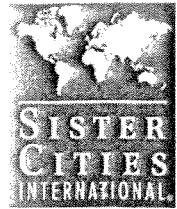

Congratulations! This is notification that the sister city relationship between the City of Milwaukee and the District of Tarime, Tanzania is now official as a result of a sister city relationship agreement being signed on November 7, 2016 during a signing ceremony at Milwaukee City Hall. The sister city relationship is valid for five years from the date of the signed agreement and will expire on November 7, 2021.

Please note that an annual report must be submitted every year to the City of Milwaukee Sister City Committee within 30 days following the anniversary of the date on which the mayor signed the resolution establishing a sister city relationship. The anniversary date of the sister city relationship with the District of Tarime is May 22nd. Therefore, please submit the first annual report to our office regarding the sister city relationship by June 21, 2017.

We look forward to maintaining this sister city relationship with you. The City of Milwaukee is a member of Sister Cities International and adheres to its policies and procedures in reviewing and maintaining relationships. We believe a limited number of such relationships are beneficial to cultural, economic, and educational growth and development for all involved.
