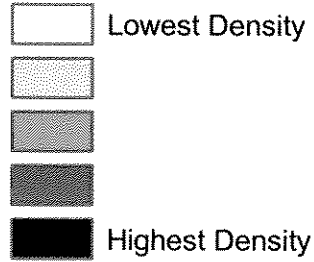

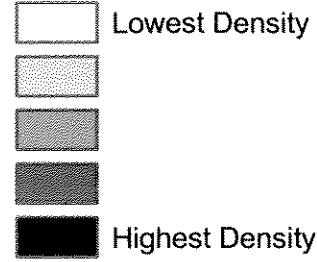

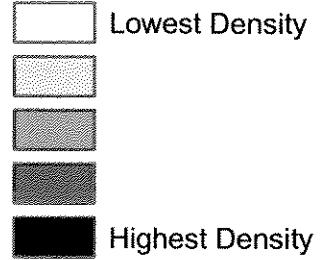

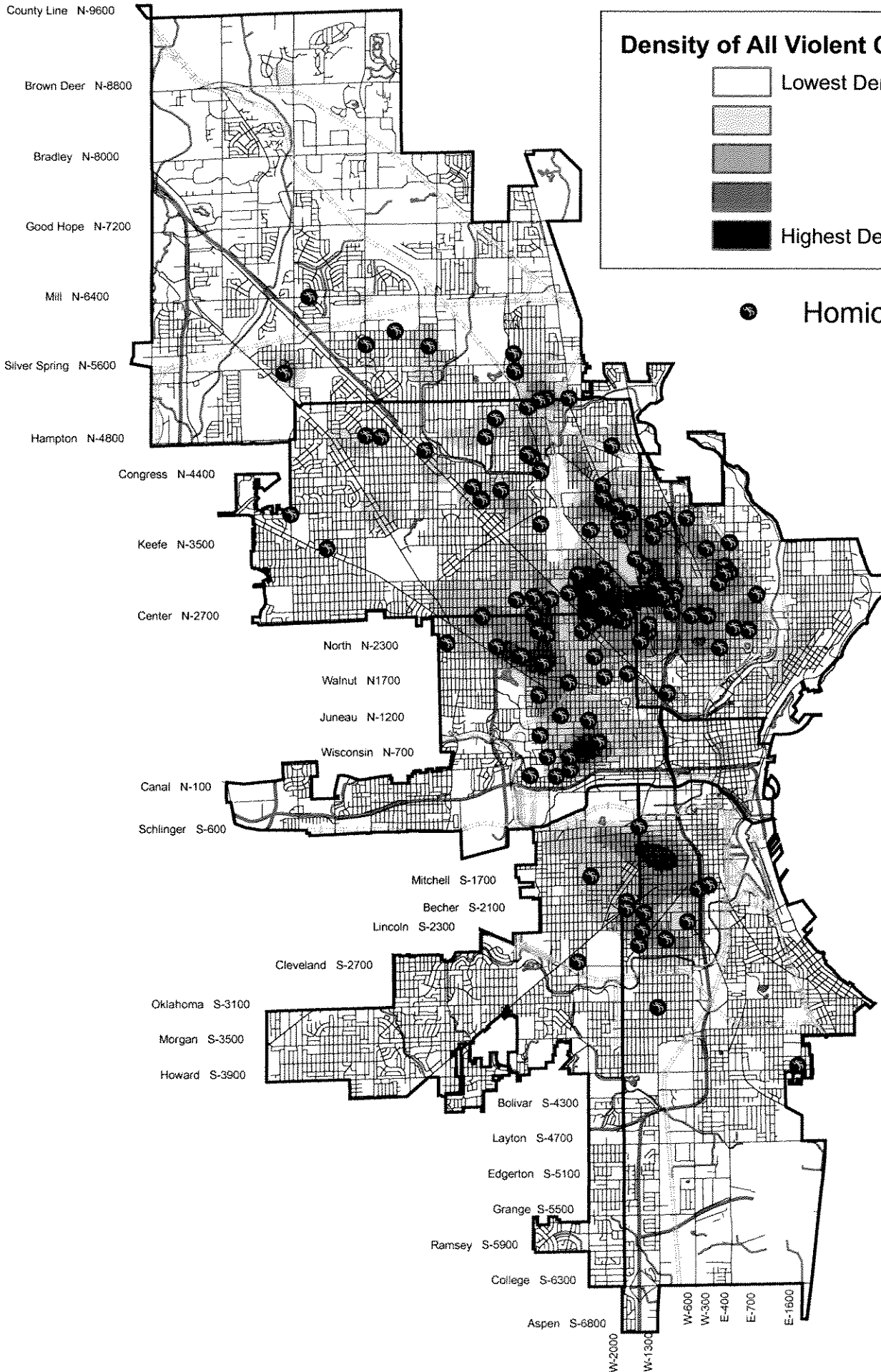
Density of All Violent Crime - 2006

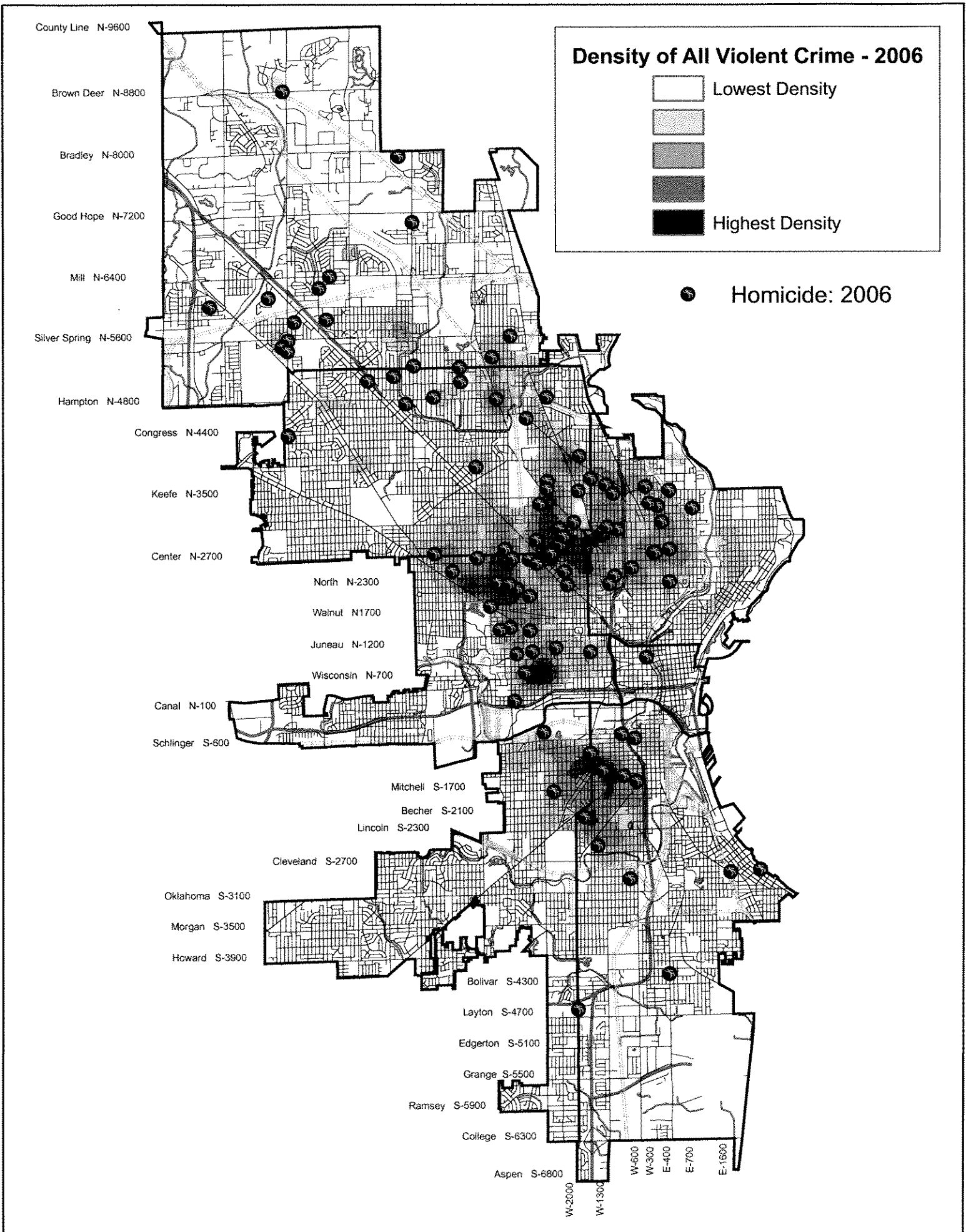


Density of All Violent Crime - 2005

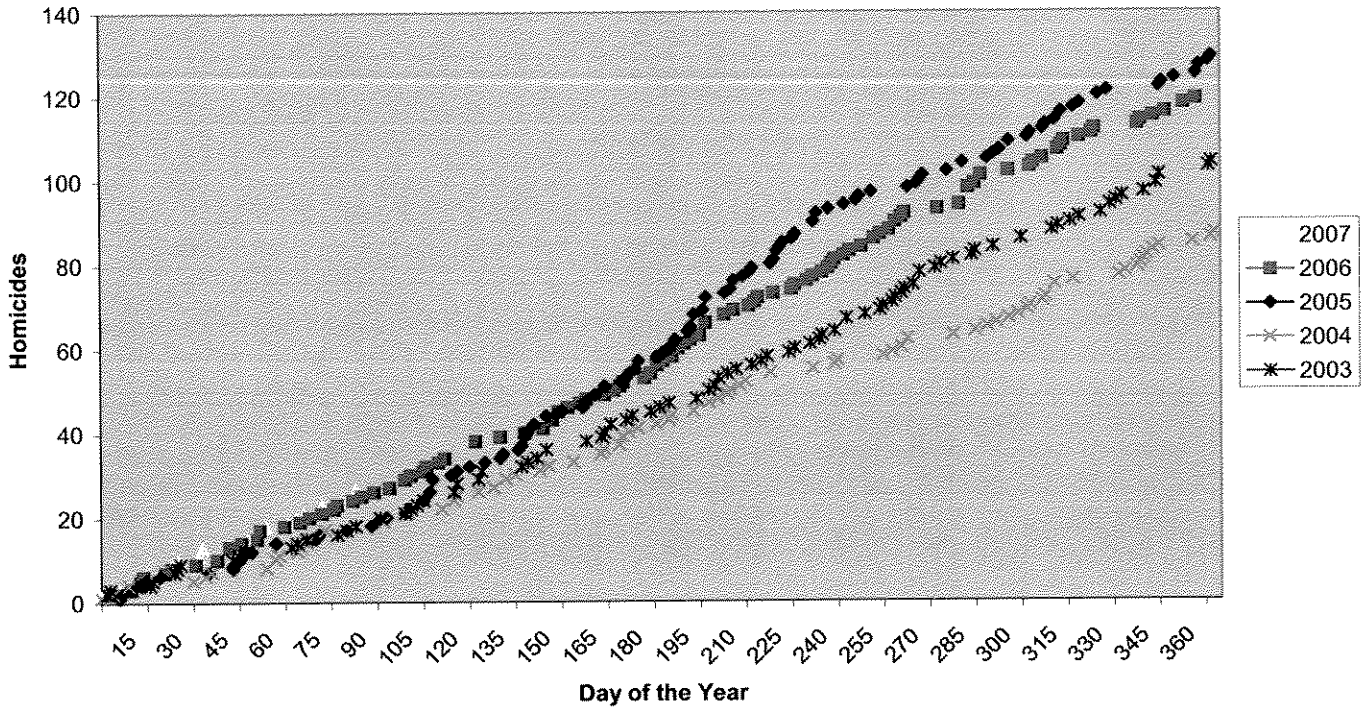

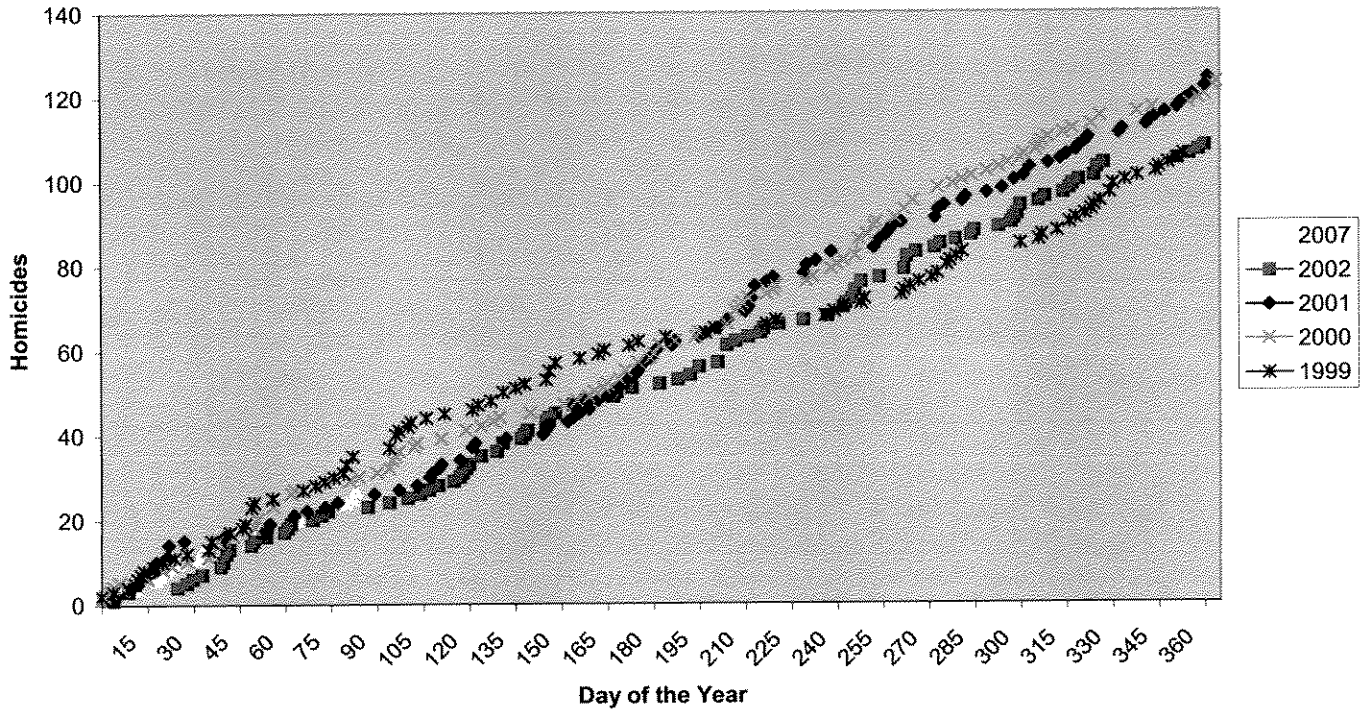




2003 - 2007 HOMICIDES
