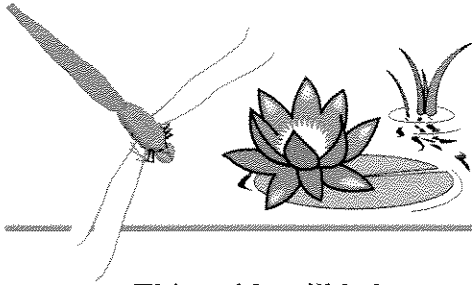




# Help Protect Lake Michigan

The Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District's Household Hazardous Waste Program serves **residents of Milwaukee County only**. Homeowners are encouraged to bring their harmful chemicals to a mobile or permanent collection site.

**This guide will help you determine what to do with hazardous products in your home.**

Key: ● Place in trash    ● Pour down the drain (if connected to a sanitary sewer)  
▲ Take to a hazardous waste collection site

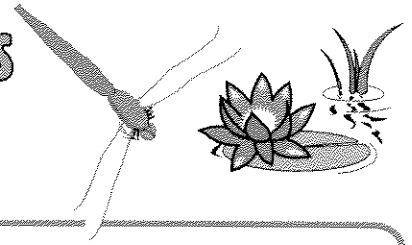

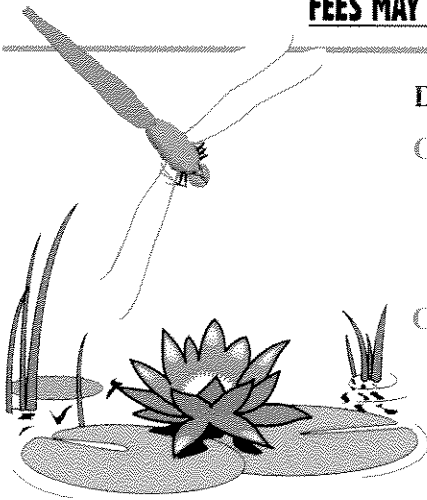

### Directions To The Permanent Household Hazardous Waste Facilities:

#### Onyx Environmental Services Northern Permanent Collection Facility

Directions: Highway 41/45 north to the Main Street (Hwy. 74) exit at Menomonee Falls; East on Main Street to North 124th Street (Boundary Road); North on Boundary Road approximately 0.8 miles; Facility is located on the west side of the road.

#### Onyx Environmental Services Southern Permanent Collection Facility

Directions: (The facility is located south of Ryan Road on South 124th Street/Hwy. 45); From Interstate 894, join I-43 and take the first exit at Hwy. 100; Continue south on Hwy. 100 to Loomis Road (Hwy. 36); Right at Loomis Road, (continuing southwest and crossing Ryan Road), to South 124th Street/Hwy. 45; Left (south) on Hwy. 45 approximately 1.5 miles; Facility is located on the east side of the road.
