There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons. The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

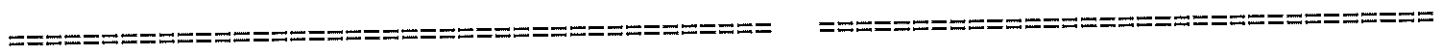
This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 02/18/2014 a Milwaukee police officer responded to 5007 West Center Street (Uptown Café) in an attempt to retrieve video regarding a burglary. After several failed attempts by phone and in person to contact the applicant, the officer gave up and no video was obtained regarding Milwaukee police incident report # 140460041.
 2. On 04/27/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a shooting at 5004 West Center Street. Two subjects were struck by gunfire. These subjects told officers they were in the area to patronize Jay's Uptown Café, but they were shot prior to entering the business. Additionally, a vehicle owned by a patron of Jay's Uptown Café was struck by gunfire. Milwaukee police incident report #141170023 filed.

3. On 11/09/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a subject with a gun complaint at 5007 West Center Street (Jay's Uptown Café). Chuck Brady, the head of security, stated there was a fight inside the premise. Brady stated two of the subjects that were fighting were kicked out and they were armed with guns. Brady believed the subjects retrieved the guns from their cars. Brady further stated a security guard was taken to the hospital. James Perry was interviewed at St Joes Hospital. Perry stated a fight broke out and when he attempted to help other security guards he was knocked to the ground by an unknown subject. While on the ground he felt a poke to the left side of his head. Perry than used his mace and sprayed the crowd. He then felt someone bite his ear. Perry received 30 stiches to the back of his head, 4 staples to

his right hand, 4 stiches to his right ear and 3 stiches to a puncture wound. The agent was on scene but did not witness the fight. No video was available for this incident. Milwaukee police incident report #143130014 filed.

4. On 03/29/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a shots fired complaint in the area of North 50th Street and West Center Street. Police received calls from citizens about shots being fired in the area as well as Shotspotter activity in the same area. After the initial call for shots fired, officers were dispatched to St. Joseph's hospital to meet a shooting victim. The victim told officers he had been at Jay's Uptown Café around 11:20pm. When he exited the business around bar close and returned to his car. The victim decided to urinate outside of his vehicle when he observed an unknown subject fire numerous shots in his direction from a long gun. The victim suffered 11 wounds as a result of this incident. Officers later discovered 15 spent casings in the area of the shooting and that the victim's car sustained damage from 15 gunshots. The agent stated there was a large crowd that night for his birthday but there were no problems inside the tavern. Milwaukee police incident report #150880024 filed.
5. On 08/23/2015 Milwaukee police were dispatched to 5007 West Center Street for a shooting and fight complaints. While at that location, officers were informed a victim had gone to St. Mary's hospital indicating he had been shot in a tavern in the area of North 49th Street and West Center Street. The victim stated he left the business with other patrons when he heard 7-8 gunshots. The victim later realized he'd been shot and was taken to the hospital. The victim suffered a gunshot wound to the foot during this incident. A total of 17 casings and 2 bullet fragments were recovered from the shooting scene. Milwaukee police incident report #152350026 filed.



6. On 01/03/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at St. Joseph's Hospital. One witness told officers she believed the victim had been involved in an altercation at a bar named "Jays", but she could not provide a location. The victim had a laceration to his head, and indicated there had been an incident at an unknown bar on the south side. The victim declined to make any other statements. An officer determined the only tavern in the city of Milwaukee named "Jays" is Jays Uptown Café (5007 West Center Street). An officer conducted follow up on 01/06/2016 at Jays Uptown Café. The officer viewed video from inside the business on the night of the incident. The officer observed nothing on camera indicating an altercation had occurred on the premises. The applicant indicated he was on scene the night of the incident and reported no problems that night. Milwaukee police incident report #160030027 filed.
7. On 01/30/2016 a Milwaukee police officer observed patrons arguing and pushing each other while exiting Jay's Uptown Café (5007 West Center Street). The disturbance ceased when the officer activated the squad's lights and siren.
8. On 03/06/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a battery complaint at 5007 West Center Street (Jay's Uptown Café). The caller told officers she was with a group of females who caused disturbance and were asked to leave. When she refused, a security guard removed her from the premise. The caller told police she was mad because security did not have to put his hands on her.

9. On 06/11/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a theft complaint at 5007 West Center Street (Jay's Uptown Café). There had been an altercation inside the business that was broken up by security. One of the involved parties dropped some personal property and another person picked it up with the intent of depriving the owner. Milwaukee police incident report #161630020 filed.
10. On 06/12/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a subject with a gun complaint in the area of North 50th Street and West Center Street. Investigation revealed there had been an altercation involving patrons inside Jay's Uptown Café and this altercation moved outside the business. A security guard from the business intervened, drawing his firearm. The security guard was arrested for endangering safety by use of a dangerous weapon. Milwaukee police incident report #161640023 filed.
11. On 06/30/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a battery cutting at St. Joseph's hospital. The victim told officers that around 2:15am there were 20-25 patrons on the sidewalk outside Jay's Uptown Café (5007 West Center Street). One person was knocked out and another person suffered a laceration on their ankle. Milwaukee police incident report #161820022 filed.
12. On 07/03/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a trouble with the subject complaint at 5007 West Center Street (Jay's Uptown Café). Officers were told that 4-5 subjects were causing a disturbance. Police were unable to locate the subjects causing the disturbance.
13. On 08/28/2016 Milwaukee police conducted an investigation regarding patrons of the premise parking between construction barrels on West Center Street in front of the premise. Officers taped off a section of the street to prevent vehicles from moving prior to being cited. A security guard went under the police tape and entered the applicant's vehicle. Officers needed to physically remove the security guard from the vehicle and escort him out of the taped off area. Patrons became upset while officers cited the parked cars and additional squads responded. A total of 12 parking citations were issued for obstructing the roadway.
14. On 10/30/16 Milwaukee Police responded to a subject with gun call at 5007 W Center (Jays Uptown Café). Officers spoke with the agent and explained to him they had received a call that a subject wearing specific clothing was in the business and possessed a firearm. The agent was cooperative and stated he did not observe anyone matching the description. He allowed officers to check the business and they did not locate anyone matching the description.
15. On 11/03/16, at 1:56am, officers responded to a shot spotter call at 5001 W Center. They also received an additional call that someone was shooting inside of Jays Uptown Café. It was later determined no shots were fired from inside the establishment. Officers did locate vehicle that was struck and a casing at 4917 W Center.
16. On 11/06/16 a Sergeant observed a large crowd gathered in front of Jays Uptown Café(5007 W Center). She then observed a fight between multiple people break out on the sidewalk. Multiple squads arrived and were able to disperse the crowd. A bouncer stated a fight between multiple females began inside and made its way to the front of the tavern until police arrived.

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17. On 11/27/2016 at 1:57am officers were monitoring the area of Jay's Uptown Café at closing. They observed a subject in the street at 4925 W. Center St firing a gun in the air. They attempted to pursue the auto the subject got into but canceled the chase due to high speeds. Security stated the subject was upset because he was turned away at closing.

18. On 01/10/2017 a meeting was held at District 3 with the applicant. The applicant state he has 5-6 security personnel and 8 cameras. He has an ID scanner but does not use it for every patron. He stated all patrons are wanded at the door. The applicant was advised to use the ID scanner for all patrons, improve his camera system and to call the police before incidents became larger problems.
19. On 01/22/2017 at 2:10am security from Jay's Uptown Café called to report 2 males with guns and females fighting in the alley. The subject had left prior to the officers arrival.
20. On 02/04/2017 at 1:08am security from Jay's Uptown Café called 911 stating there was a fight and there were now 3 subjects with guns outside the premise. The officers spoke with security who stated they were at capacity and people became upset when they could not enter the tavern. Security had used pepper spray then observed three people with guns. The subjects were gone when the police arrived.
21. On 02/19/2017 at 1:47am officers responded to a Shotspotter call at 4933 W. Center St. The officers located two victims with graze wounds at N. 50th St and W. Center St. The witness stated all parties in the shooting were drinking at Jay's Uptown Café just prior to the shooting.
22. On 03/25/2017 at 1:18am officer were dispatched to Jay's Uptown Café, 5007 W. Center St for a subject with gun complaint. The officer observed a group of females being kicked out of the tavern. One female was requesting her property from inside. The applicant stated they could not locate the property. When the officers came back out the females were gone. No one approached the officers about a subject with gun.
23. On 04/22/2017 at 1:59am officers responded to Jay's Uptown Café, 5007 W. Center St, for a subject with gun complaint. The officer spoke with the applicant who stated there was no problem and the call was for his armed security guard escorting someone to their vehicle.
24. On 05/14/2017 at 10:58pm an officer observed a group of 100-150 people standing near the entrance to Jay's Uptown Café, 5007 W. Center St. and cars cruising the area. The officer observed the entrance to the bar was blocked and the bar was not letting any more patrons in the bar. The applicant was advised to have his security clear the crowd. The crowd refused and more officers responded. The large police response resulted in a back log of calls for service.
25. On 05/21/2017 at 11:25pm officers responded to a noise nuisance complaint at Jay's Uptown Café, 5007 W. Center St. The officer advised the premise to keep the music down and the caller was satisfied with that resolution.

This report is written by P.O. Michael FASULO, District #3, Late Power Shift.

On Sunday, November 27, 2016 at 1:57am, Officers were monitoring the area around the premise as it was approaching closing time. Officers observed traffic stopped in front of the premise facing east bound. Officers approached in a squad to move traffic when a b/m male subject was observed at 4925 W. Center St. lift his hand into the air and began discharging a firearm. Officers activated the emergency lights of the squad and proceeded into the wrong lane of traffic to get around the stopped vehicles. Officers observed the vehicle the suspect was standing next to begin to flee the scene. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle as it proceeded south on 49th St. from Center St. Officers terminated pursuit do to the fleeing vehicles high rate of speed. Officers proceeded back to the location of the shots fired and recovered 6 40 S&W casings. Security from the premise stated they believed the suspect was a patron that was turned away at the door do to closing.

This report is written by P.O. Michael FASULO, District #3, Late Power Shift.

On Tuesday, January 10, 2017 at 1:00pm in the District #3 conference room a meeting was held with licensee

Odean H. TAYLOR (b/m,03-26-79) regarding the premise at 5007 W. Center St. The focus of the meeting was to improve communication between the licensee and Police Department to lessen incidents regarding the premise.

TAYLOR stated that his busiest days are Wednesday, Friday and Saturday nights. Currently TAYLOR has security inside the premise and a security guard outside the premise during the times of operation. TAYLOR stated he usually has 5-6 security personnel working with 1 being armed in addition to 3 bartenders. TAYLOR's premise currently has 8 video cameras with 5 inside and 3 outside with a recording system that stores for 3 days. TAYLOR does have an identification reader, but it is not used to record all patrons. PATRONS are physically patted down and scanned with a security wand at the front door. Cliental are currently 21 and up with a dress code of no hooded sweatshirts, white t-shirts or baseball caps.

Suggestions provided to TAYLOR were an improvement to his recording of video equipment storage. TAYLOR stated he is currently looking for a new system and had been quoted a price of \$4300.00. The use of the identification reader to be used for all patrons upon entry as it would be beneficial for Police investigations for patrons from the premise who are involved in incidents when partial information about their identity is provided. TAYLOR was advised of the advantage of using female security personnel to check female patrons and their bags instead of using male security. TAYLOR was informed of calling the District #3 shift commander for minor incidents at the premise to facilitate a faster response to assist his security to prevent the issues from becoming larger. TAYLOR was also informed of the importance of the premise calling 911 for major issues surrounding the premise that his security or patrons made him aware of. TAYLOR was advised of the necessity to keep count of his occupancy.

TAYLOR acknowledged the suggestions provided and made a request for additional patrol at his premise as closing time.

I parked my marked squad, with the emergency lights activated, in front of the bar. I could hear the security officers telling the patrons outside that they were not allowing anyone else into the club. Security had placed a large metal fence in front of the doors to keep anyone from coming in. The patrons outside were yelling and becoming angry. I then requested additional squads to respond.

Once squads responded, I spoke to the owner, Taylor, Odean H. (m/b. d.o.b. 03/26/79) who told me that the patrons were there following a promotional event which took place at a different location. I informed Taylor that his security officers needed to clear the area in front of the bar. Taylor stated that he understood and told security officers to clear the area. After several commands from security, the crowd remained in place and refused to leave. I heard several people yell that they had paid to get into the bar and they wanted their money back.

Due to the congestion in the streets and on the sidewalk, I shut down motor vehicle traffic from N. 51st St. to N. 48th St. on W. Center Street. I instructed officers to begin issuing parking citations to the illegally parked vehicles. Additionally, a City of Milwaukee tow truck was called in to begin towing cars that were eligible.

After approximately 1 1/2 hours, MPD officers on scene were able to clear out the crowd as well as the traffic congestion. Traffic was then opened up for normal travel. I left one 2 man squad on scene for the remainder of the evening to monitor the bar until closing time.

I wish to express my strong **objection** to a proposed **Retail Food Dealer license application for 3133 W. Lisbon Ave.**

I have lived at _____ about a quarter block from the property in question. The property is easily visible from my house and I walk or drive by it daily. My specific objections include:

1. The neighborhood through Washington Park Partners has taken a strong position that our neighborhood is already saturated with such convenience stores and we do not want any more. These are a liability and not an asset to our quality of life.
- 2: There is a convenience store at Lisbon Gas and Food at 3033 W. Lisbon, a short block away, and another convenience store at 32nd and Brown, just a block and a half away.
3. The prostitution problem between 28th and 34th along Lisbon Avenue is out of control. During my involvement with the Department of Justice's Byrne Initiative in Washington Park over the past three years, I learned that prostitution requires convenience stores as part of the prostitution infrastructure in order for prostitution to thrive. There are also a convenience stores at 33rd and Galena, 30th and Brown, two near 27th and Lisbon, and a liquor store at 29th and Lisbon – we are saturated!
4. This property was operated as a convenience store for a number of years in the past before being shut down following a Federal ATF (Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms) raid. During that time the store was open the amount of litter, loitering and prostitution increased substantially.
5. There is a child care directly across the street, Children's Pantry, which must deal with the very visible prostitution. A convenience store would only add to our struggle to get a handle on this perennial problem.
6. Those of us who have lived in this neighborhood for many years, 28 years in my case, need the city to support our collective efforts to make this neighborhood as safe as possible. We struggle daily in our efforts and need to know the city and our elected officials have our back.
7. Alderman Stamper has been outstanding in his presence and visibility in the neighborhood, his understanding of the neighborhood resident's wishes is appreciated.

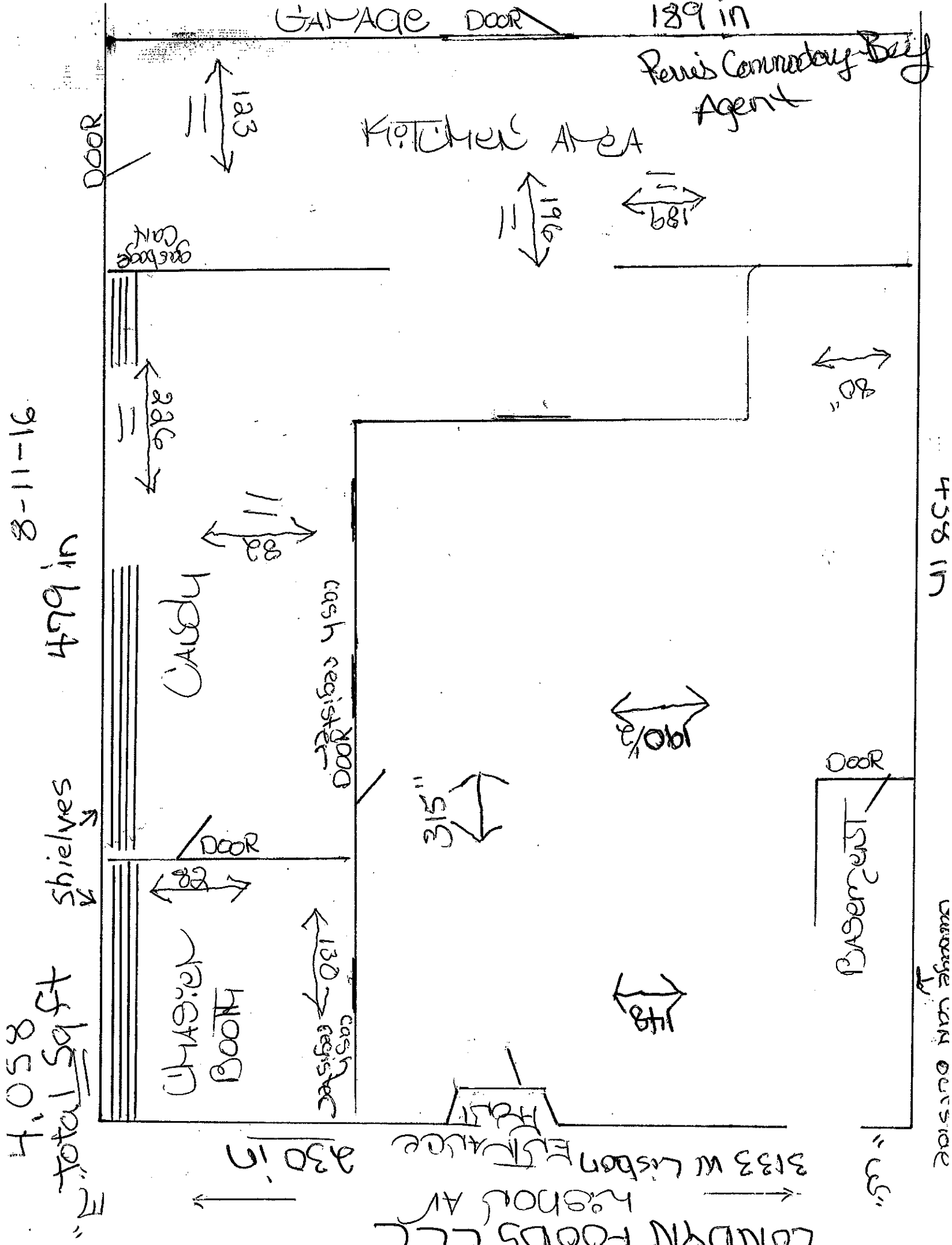

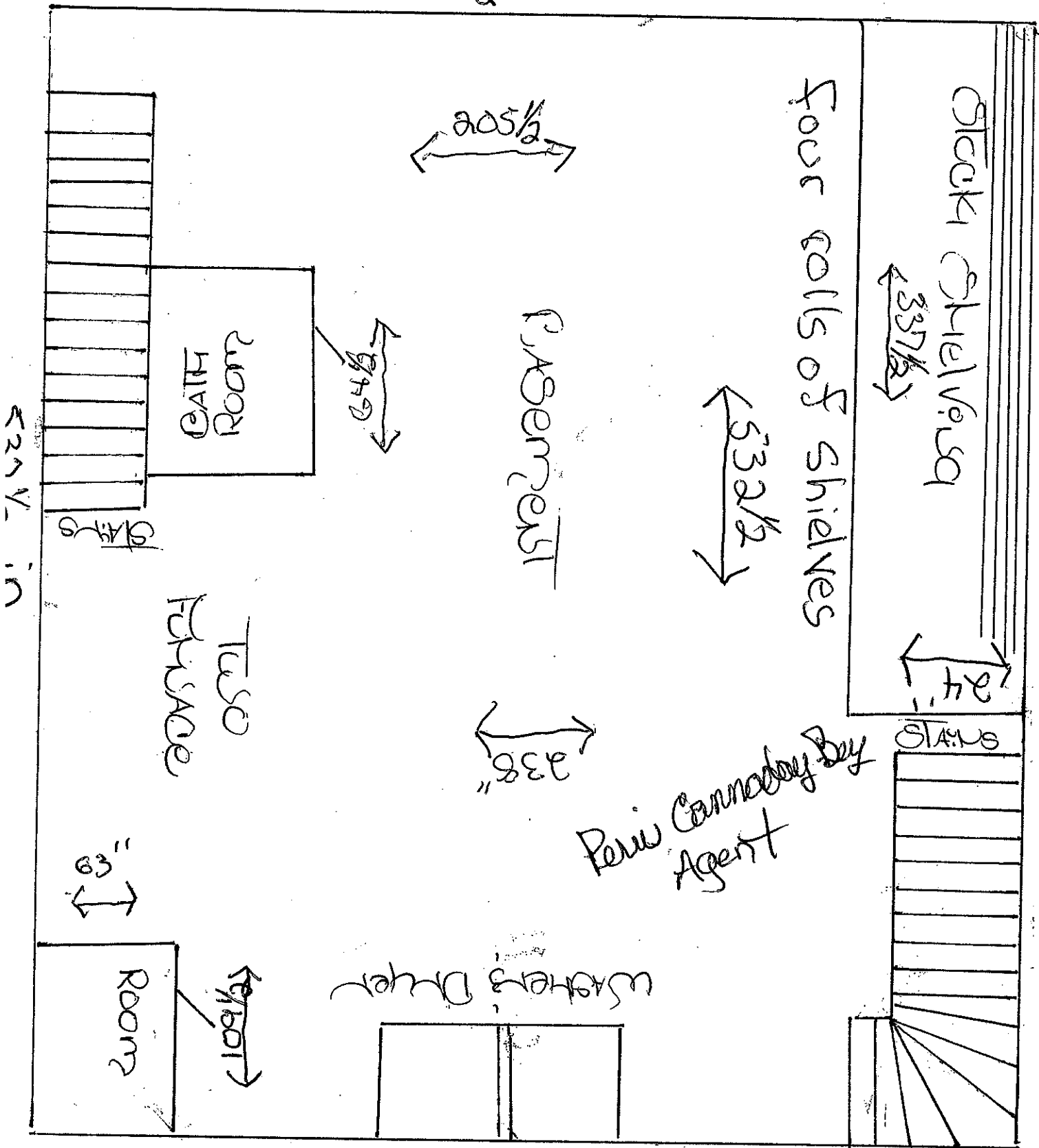

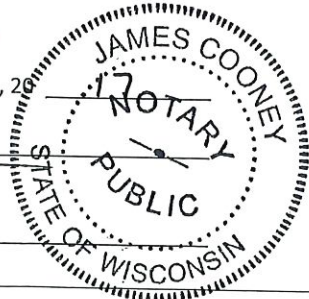

PA-33E Narrative

On July 6, 2017 at 8:53 p.m P.O Larry LEIBSLE and P.O. Michael JONES, squad 3450 were dispatched to an armed robbery at Quick Foods located at 3833 W. Center located in the City and County of Milwaukee WI.

Upon arrival we spoke to the caller/victim who identified himself as Ernest THURMAN (b/m 10/22/1947). THURMAN stated that an unknown actor came into the store at approximately 8:30 p.m. and opened two bags of pork grind potato chips, THURMAN told the unknown actor that if he did not pay for the two bags of pork grind potato chips that he could not come back into the store.

Thurman Stated at approximately 8:35 p.m. the unknown actor attempted to come back into the store.

THURMAN stated that he stopped the unknown actor at the door. THURMAN stated that the unknown actor pushed his way through the door knocking him to the ground. While on the ground THURMAN stated that the unknown actor stood over him and said "I got you now old man". THURMAN Stated that the unknown actor pulled out a small caliber hand gun with a pearl handle and struck him five to six times in the face. Thurman stated that the unknown actor ran out the door and fled south bound on center.

THURMAN informed us that the surveillance video in the store did work. P.O LEIBSLE and I reviewed the video footage and were not able to obtain a positive identification of the suspect due to the poor quality of the camera system.

We did observe a small (1/4 inch) laceration to the right side of his temple. Medical attention was refused by THURMAN.

THURMAN described the subject as a black male in his early to mid-20's light complexion with braids wearing gray jogging pants, and a white tee-shirt. The video surveillance that we observed matched the description of the unknown actor that was given by THURMAN.

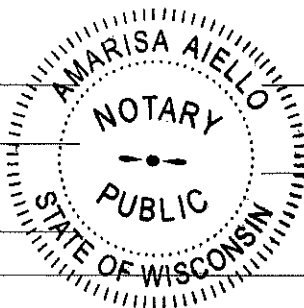
