### FINDINGS OF FACT

- Î. Michelle D'Antonio (hereinafter the "licensee") holds a Class "D" Operator's license in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Said license expires at midnight, December 31, 2012.
- 2. An application to renew said license was filed with the Office of the City Clerk on July 20, 2012.
- 3. Pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances the matter was referred to the Milwaukee Police Department for investigation. The Milwaukee Police Department responded with a report dated July 23, 2012, which could form the basis for denial or suspension of this license.
- 4. On September 19, 2012, the City Clerk's Office provided notice to the licensee, pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances of the police report that could be the basis of non-renewal or suspension of this license. The licensee was provided a copy of the police report with the notice of hearing. The matter was scheduled for a hearing on the police report on October 1, 2012 at 1:00 p.m. The licensee did not appear and she was not represented by counsel. This was the licensee's second nonappearance.
- 5. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following:



A. A notice of the hearing was sent to Michelle D'Antonio at 1522 N. Humboldt Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53211 on September 19, 2012 by U.S. prepaid first-class mail in an envelope bearing the return address of the License Division. The address of 1522 N. Humboldt Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53211 is the address given by the licensee on her application. The envelope was not returned to the License Division by the United States Postal Service. The licensee failed to appear at two hearings following proper notice and mailing by United States first-class prepaid mail.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provided Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
- 2. Based upon the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the licensee has not met the criteria of Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances to allow renewal of her Class "D" Operator's license based upon the above findings of fact.
- 3. In order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Licenses Committee that the full Common Council of the City of Milwaukee should exercise its judgment to not renew the Class "D" Operator's license of Michelle D'Antonio based upon the above findings of fact.

# RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee recommends, by a vote of five (5) ayes and zero (0) noes, that the Class "D" Operator's license of Michelle D'Antonio not be renewed.

- The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provided Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapters 74 and 85 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
- Based upon the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the licensee has not met the criteria of Chapter 74 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances to allow renewal of his Ice Cream Peddler license based on the above-stated findings of fact.
- 3. In order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Licenses Committee that the full Common Council of the City of Milwaukee should exercise its judgment to not renew the Ice Cream Peddler license of Jose-Miguel Hernandez based on the above-stated findings of fact,
