You are hereby commanded to summon David G. Martin to appear before the Licenses Committee of the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee at its meeting in Room 301-A, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, in the City and County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin on May 18, 2006 at 9:00 a.m. to show cause why the dwelling facility (room house) license issued to David G. Martin for the premises at 500 West Maple Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin should not be revoked or suspended.

Pursuant to Chapter 275 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Milwaukee, you are hereby commanded to appear on May 18, 2006 at 9:00 a.m. at a hearing before the City's Licenses Committee to be held in Room 301-A, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin to show cause why your dwelling facility (room house) license should not be revoked or suspended. The hearing is being initiated because of the City of Milwaukee's receipt of a complaint, filed by James N. Witkowiak, seeking revocation of the dwelling facility (room house) issued for your establishment located at 500 West Maple Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. A copy of this complaint is attached hereto. You are also being provided with a copy of sec. 275 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

On May 18, 2006 at 9:00 a.m., you will be given an opportunity to speak on your own behalf, and to respond to and challenge any charges or reasons given by witnesses at the aforementioned hearing in support of a revocation or suspension of your license. You may present your own supporting witnesses, under oath, at this hearing, and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses. If you wish to do so, and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your own choosing to represent you at this hearing.

If you, David G. Martin, fail to appear in person before the Committee on May 18, 2006 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 301-A, of City Hall, as required by the Summons, the Committee will proceed to consider the allegations of the Complaint, which allegations shall be taken as true. If the Committee determines that the allegations are sufficient, the law requires that the license shall be revoked or suspended.
