
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

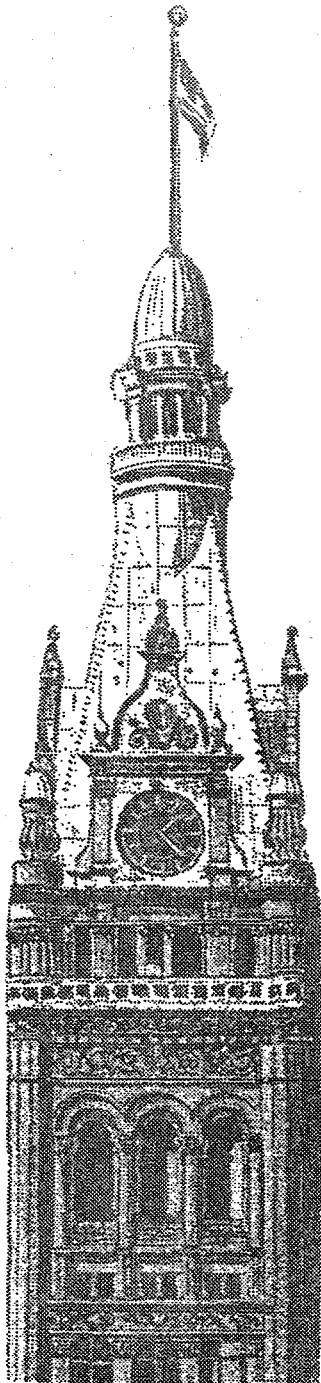


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

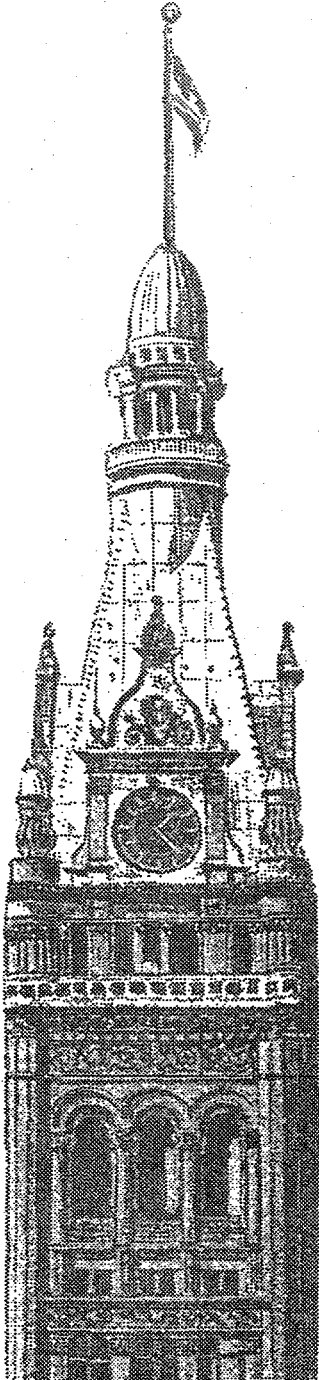

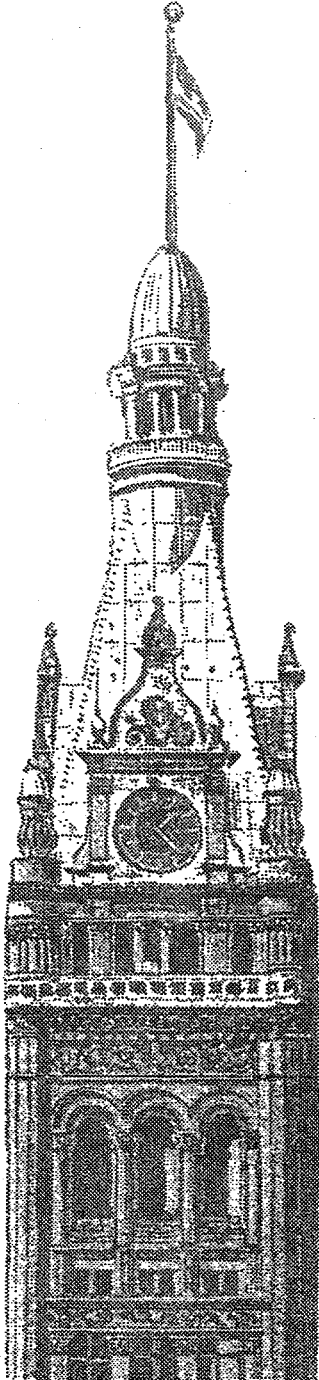

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Derry L. Groce (hereinafter the "Licensee") is the holder of a Class "D" Bartender License in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Said license expired at midnight, December 31, 2002.
2. An application to renew said license was filed with the Office of the City Clerk on December 10, 2002.
3. Pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the matter was referred to the Milwaukee Police Department for investigation. On December 11, 2002, the Milwaukee Police Department responded with a police report that created a basis for non-renewal or suspension of said license.
4. On December 19, 2002, the City Clerk's Office provided timely notice to the Licensee pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes of the report of the Milwaukee Police Department and included therewith a copy of the Milwaukee Police Department report. The matter was scheduled for a hearing on the Police Department report on January 7, 2003, commencing at 9:45 a.m. in Room 301B of City Hall. At said date, time and place, the Licensee appeared and was not represented by counsel.
5. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following:



- A. On September 23, 1982 the applicant was arrested by the Milwaukee police for burglary and found guilty on April 11, 1983 and sentenced to 1 year and 8 months probation.
- C. On August 26, 1986 the applicant was arrested by Milwaukee police for theft, battery, and obstructing and was found guilty of theft and battery on November 18, 1986 and sentenced to 45 days in the House of Corrections and 2 years probation.
- D. On February 12, 1987 the applicant was arrested by Milwaukee County Sheriff for escape violations and was found guilty on May 7, 1987 and fined.
- E. On February 28, 1994 the applicant was charged in Milwaukee Circuit Court with possession of a controlled substance-marijuana and fined \$250 on April 23, 1994.
- F. On May 11, 1995 the applicant was charged in Milwaukee Circuit Court with felony failure to support and found guilty on April 11, 1997 and sentence to 3 years probation.
- G. On September 8, 2002, a Milwaukee police officer made a lawful inspection of the licensed premises at 408 East North Avenue, the Blue Gardenia. The applicant was found to be in possession of a loaded handgun. A patron of the establishment was also found to be in possession of a controlled substance and a loaded handgun. The applicant was charged in Milwaukee County Circuit Court with felon in possession of a firearm and carrying a concealed weapon on October 31, 2002 and sentenced to 6 months in the House of Corrections and fined \$170.00.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provide Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter of the Wisconsin Statutes and Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.
2. Based upon the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the licensee, Mr. Derry L. Groce does not meet the criteria necessary to allow renewal of his Class "D" Bartender license.

3. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Utilities and Licenses Committee that the full Common Council of the City of Milwaukee should exercise its judgment to not renew the Class "D" Bartender license of Derry L. Groce based upon his past activities as a licensee and for the danger that the continued licensure of Derry L. Groce poses to the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee.

RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee, by a vote of three (3) ayes to zero (0) noes, recommends that the Class "D" Bartender License of Derry L. Groce not be renewed based on his past activities as a licensee.


