I called the city clerk's office around the end of September to check on my claim that was sent to the City Clerk's office the end of July 2004. It was still in the office. Why!

Regarding my welfare — My next door neighbor told the police officers that she had seen me the morning before getting into a car. If the police had waited 24 hours, I would have been back home.
