There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

I just moved . There is a 24 store across the street. The alidry on the other corner used to be 24 hours and recently raised its prices and shortened its hours. The number of meth users and other housing challenged drug users is outrageous. The building just North of me seems to be best friends with these people and for weeks let them park their stolen U-haul in the parking space. (Luckily, the police finally towed that vehicle.) The barber shop just south of me also seems to be very close to the people who roam the streets all night long.

I NEED a fence put up between the barber shop building and my apartment.

The barber shop says that they have cameras, but the people running the shop are friends with the vagrants. I have found these people doing drugs on my front steps, next to my house, sleeping next to my house, having sex next to my house. There are needles all over the ground.

AS THIS IS A SAFETY ISSUE, is there any funding for community improvements or something that can be accessed to build a fence. As a renter, I can't force my landlord to build a fence and the housing challenged do not care about cameras or motion sensor lights. All night long they are in between our buildings. They drag garbage cans and shopping carts around all night. They don't realize or care how loud they are. I am a teacher. I need to sleep at night, but I can't. I don't want to call the police to play cat and mouse games all night long. We need a solution.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 10/15/24 at 12:07p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 1110 W. Greenfield Ave. Assisting in this assignment were agents from Wisconsin Department of Revenue Alcohol and Tobacco. The following violations were found and tobacco products were seized by the Agent. The business was cooperative.
  - Post Valid Seller's Permit
  - All products must be purchased by a legitimate source and invoices must be kept on premise
  - Cease purchasing from unauthorized source immediately
2. On 10/31/24 at 10:31a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Armed Robbery at 1110 W. Greenfield Ave. Investigation revealed a subject was creating a disturbance and when asked to leave, began to take items and behave erratically. The employee confronted the suspect, at which time the employee was attacked, punched and stabbed. The suspect left but returned with a machete and chased an employee through the store. The suspect was arrested on scene and the business was cooperative.

The following items pertain to the above listed business

3. On 08/16/25 at 4:22a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. Investigation revealed this was a Battery that occurred outside the business, however, the business was very cooperative, providing video surveillance assisting in the officer's investigation.
4. On 08/17/25 at 10:29a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to check for a Stolen Auto. On arrival officers were unable to locate the vehicle, however, the business was cooperative in providing video surveillance of the driver who attempted to purchase tobacco but was denied the sale due to no ID.
5. On 08/17/25 at 11:30p.m., Milwaukee Police observed subjects loitering and possibly drug dealing in the parking lot. The business is known as a standing complainant and officers deterred further activity with their presence.

On Saturday, August 16th, 2025, AND 4:22AM, (PO Julius TORRES and myself were dispatched to 1100 W Greenfield Ave for a battery complaint.

Upon our arrival I observed MFD on scene and inside the business known as Greenfield Pantry. MFD was attending to a subject later identified as Elizabeth ROEDER (b/f 5/16/1979) who was refusing medical from MFD. ELIZABETH initially stated that she was beat up by her boyfriend. Once bell ambulance paramedics arrived on scene, she became more cooperative and entered the ambulance vehicle to go to St Lukes for medical treatment.

Elizabeth stated that she was in a Blue small sedan vehicle with her boyfriend who she got into an argument with and he pulled over in front of the above listed business/address and had struck her multiple times. Elizabeth stated she ran into the Greenfield Pantry to call 911 and waited for medical and Police to arrive.

Officers were shown surveillance video of the incident Elizabeth was describing to Officers and attendant at the business was more than willing to show us the video and had it up on the screen already for Officers to view.

The business was cooperative with the investigation. The business had 0 security officers on scene.

I reviewed video surveillance footage. The footage showed a Blue small sedan driving east bound on W Greenfield St from S 12th St and two subjects exit the vehicle a male and female. Later was determined the male was the suspect a Black Male nickname "Rio" and our victim beating the female in the video. In the video it is seen the male subject striking the female in the video and the male subject getting back in

Sergeant MANIGOLD interviewed MAXWELL who stated that she did go to the store, but SINGH initially pushed her which is why she spit at his direction. MAXWELL was very upset we were speaking to her and was advised not to return to the pantry.

Upon arriving on scene, we spoke with the caller, SINGH, Durpreet (I/M 5-26-98) regarding the incident.

On listed date, day, and time the subject, FORT, Savonte D (B/M 01-17-92) entered convenience store and asked SINGH if he had "weed". SINGH showed FORT a small bag of synthetic THC, A Exotic flower brand. FORT grabbed the bag and begin to open it. SINGH told him he needed to pay for it first. FORT started walking towards the exit door but SINGH locked the doors. FORT started yelling incoherent phrases like he belonged to the illuminati, he was the owner of the store , and would kill everyone. FORT then knocked over a lottery ticket scanner causing it to break and causing approximately 500.00 dollars worth of damage. the scanner was located on the cashier counter on the southwest end of counter. SINGH then unlocked the doors and FORT left the premises.

We were able to locate FORT in the intersection of S 7th St and W Lapham BLVD and detained him. We were able to locate FORT because an employee followed FORT and pointed him out to police. A check with DOT revealed no wants or warrants. FORT was issued a citation for vandalism (110-15 Cit # J981S8CTKG) and released.

On Thursday, November 27, 2025, at approximately 6:59 a.m., while assigned to Squad 2330 (P.O. Mohammad ISMAIL and I) were dispatched to a Battery complaint, at St. Luke's hospital ER room B05, located at the address of 2900 W. Oklahoma Ave, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

According to CAD notes prior to arrival, the victim had been transported to St. Luke's Hospital by Milwaukee Fire Department Medical Unit 3 following a medical emergency. Upon our arrival at the hospital, we entered the Emergency Department and were directed by staff to ER Room B05, where the victim was being treated.

### VICTIM INFORMATION:

Inside ER Room B05, we observed the victim lying in a hospital bed receiving medical care. The victim was described by staff as a Hispanic male, medium build, approximately 5 feet 9 inches tall, weighing approximately 180 pounds. He had short brown hair and a goatee. At the time of his arrival to the Emergency Department, the victim had been wearing a blue windbreaker-style jacket, a gray Milwaukee Bucks T-shirt, and gray sweatpants displaying a Milwaukee Bucks logo.

The victim's identity was unknown at the time of this report. Hospital personnel advised the victim had been admitted as "John Doe." The victim was not conscious and was unable to provide identifying information or a statement.

Medical staff advised that the victim had been admitted to the hospital at approximately 6:25 a.m., approximately 34 minutes prior to our arrival, and was under the care of Dr. Maerz.

## MEDICAL OBSERVATIONS AND CONDITION:

Hospital staff informed us that the victim had suffered a small laceration to the back of his head. While we were present in the emergency department, the victim continued to experience active seizure activity. Due to the severity and frequency of the seizures, medical personnel made the decision to intubate the victim in order to protect his airway and stabilize his condition.

Staff advised that additional medical examinations were pending at the time, including X-rays and a CT scan, in order to rule out internal injuries, skull fractures, or bleeding. Medical personnel stated that the observed injuries were possibly consistent with a head injury caused by collapsing during a seizure, though they were unable to rule out trauma caused by assault at that time.

## INFORMATION FROM MILWAUKEE FIRE DEPARTMENT:

Members of the Milwaukee Fire Department who transported the victim advised that the victim had been located at the Blue Kangaroo Laundromat, located at 1115 W. Greenfield Avenue, Milwaukee. Fire personnel stated that when they arrived on scene, the victim was in an altered mental state and actively experiencing a seizure. Due to the victim's condition, medical transport was immediately initiated, and the victim was taken directly to St. Luke's Hospital for emergency treatment.

## WITNESS / CALLER INFORMATION:

During the course of the investigation, we later made telephone contact with the reporting party, later identified as Ana GONZALEZ (White Female, DOB 08/11/1971), an employee at the Blue Kangaroo Laundromat.

Ms. GONZALEZ advised that she only speaks Spanish and does not understand English. Communication was conducted using limited English and clarification as needed. GONZALEZ stated that the victim entered the laundromat stumbling and appearing disoriented. She stated she was unable to understand what the victim was saying due to the language barrier and the victim's condition. GONZALEZ further stated she observed blood on the back of the victim's head, which caused her concern. Due to the victim's condition, she requested medical assistance by calling emergency services.

## SURVEILLANCE FOOTAGE:

While Squad 2330 remained at the hospital with the victim, Squad 2320 (P.O. Santiago and P.O. Garcia) responded to the liquor store located at 1110 W. Greenfield Avenue, which is directly across the street from the laundromat. The purpose of their response was to review surveillance footage that may have captured events leading up to the victim's injuries.

According to information later relayed, the surveillance footage showed that at approximately 5:44 a.m., the victim was standing outside the liquor store with four to five other subjects. Shortly afterward, an apparent altercation occurred between the victim and two male subjects later designated as S1 and S2.

The suspects were described as follows:

***S1: Black male, slim build, wearing a black jacket, blue jeans, hood pulled over his head.***

***S2: Black male, slim build, wearing a black jacket, hood up, and gray sweatpants.***

The footage shows the victim running across W. Greenfield Avenue toward the area of the laundromat, with S1 and S2 actively chasing him. S1 and S2 then caught up to the victim near the front area of the laundromat, where both suspects were observed striking the victim multiple times. As a result of the assault, the victim fell backward to the ground and appeared motionless.

After the assault:

S1 fled northbound through the alley west of the liquor store.

S2 entered a blue, four-door sedan, unknown make or model, and fled the scene in an unknown

## **FOLLOW-UP:**

Squad 2180 (P.O. Bradley KWIATKOWSKI) conducted follow-up investigation at the liquor store and recovered the surveillance footage depicting the assault. P.O. KWIATKOWSKI documented and recovered the video evidence. Refer to his supplemental report for detailed evidence handling and observations.

## **VICTIM STATUS:**

Subsequent to the initial emergency room treatment, hospital staff advised that the victim had been transferred to ICU Room L2408. At the time, the victim remained unconscious and intubated, though staff stated he was in stable condition. Medical personnel informed us that the CT scan results were negative, revealing no signs of internal bleeding. Staff further stated they suspected the victim may have a history of seizure disorder and possibly a prior traumatic brain injury, which could have contributed to his medical episode following the assault.

## **NOTIFICATION:**

Acting Lieutenant / Sergeant SLOWINSKI was notified of the incident and briefed on the investigation. We were advised that Criminal Investigation Bureau (CIB) would not be responding at this time. We were further instructed to request a Forensic Investigator in an attempt to identify the victim through fingerprint comparison due to his unconscious state and lack of identification.

Shortly thereafter, Squad 1721 arrived at the hospital, collected the victim's fingerprints, and conducted CST duties. Refer to their supplemental report for documentation of fingerprint recovery and processing.

## **DOCUMENTATION:**

A PV-17 form was completed and left with the nurse in charge of the victim's care. Hospital staff were advised to notify law enforcement once the victim regains consciousness and is medically able to communicate in order to obtain a statement and further identification.

At the conclusion of this report, the victim remains hospitalized and unidentified. Suspects are not in custody, and the investigation is ongoing pending victim identification, victim statement, and further follow-up.

On Thursday, November 27, 2025, at approximately 11:47 a.m., I received updated information from a Forensic Investigator regarding a positive identification of the victim in this incident. The Forensic Investigator identified the victim as Londyn A. Alvarez (W/M, DOB 08/05/1993) through the fingerprint system.

I further reviewed surveillance footage that was recovered by P.O. Kwiatkowski from the exterior of the liquor store located at 1110 W. Greenfield Ave. From the surveillance footage, I was able to obtain a license plate number from the vehicle that one of the suspects entered and used to flee the scene following the assault. While inside the establishment, officers observed the posted business licenses, which were up to date. No violations were observed at this time.

The vehicle was identified as a blue 2025 Kia K4 bearing Wisconsin registration **BBG-8717** and VIN **3KPFT4DE3SE162035**. A DOT check revealed that the vehicle is registered to the following individuals:

- Michael D. Robertson (B/M, DOB 06/30/2006)
- Montrelle D. Johnson (B/M, DOB 02/10/1997)

Both individuals are listed as residing at 5713 N. 68th Street.

I also reviewed interior surveillance footage from the liquor store, which showed that at approximately 8:33 a.m., Suspect #2 returned to the store. Suspect #2 was observed wearing the same exact clothing as during the incident.

The footage showed Suspect #2 entering the store and approaching the register counter to purchase a black and mild cigar. The video captured the suspect whispering to the clerk and asking, "Are the police looking for me?" The clerk responded by asking if the suspect had beaten anyone up the previous night. The suspect then asked the clerk, "Do they know me?" and "Do they know my name?"

The clerk replied, "Not the name, but they saw the video, your car, blue car, but yeah they took the video and everything and they should be looking for the car." The clerk then asked the suspect, "Who did you beat up though?" The suspect responded, "Some crack head dude that was trying to break into a car."

Using the information obtained from the vehicle run-off, I conducted a search through the RMS system, which revealed that Montrelle D. JOHNSON (B/M, DOB 02/10/1997) has a prior record with the Milwaukee Police Department and has been arrested for other incidents. I compared the booking photograph obtained from the RMS system with a still photograph from the surveillance footage, and the images were an exact match.

I entered a Suspect Alert and Temp Felony Want for JOHNSON, regarding his involvement in this incident.
