There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 10/23/23 at 12:30a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Spotshotter at 1405 W. Lincoln Av. On arrival officers observed a large group of people arguing in the street, however, ran into 1428 W. Lincoln when they observed police. On entrance, the officers determined this was an argument between the bartender and a patron. The agent was on scene and cooperative and stated this had nothing to do with the business as it initiated outside and was a personal matter between the subjects. Later a subject a arrived at a local hospital with a laceration to their head and it was determined to have occurred at the establishment. The victim stated they were hit in the head with a chair due to a large group fighting and fled the location due to the altercation.

#### LICENSED PREMISE REPORT

This report is written by PO Daniel FINN, assigned to District 2, late shift, squad 2350 (PO Nicholas WILCKENS).

On Monday October 23, 2023, at approximately 12:30am, we were dispatched to 1405 W Lincoln Ave for a report of a shotspotter.

Upon our arrival I observed multiple people in the street arguing, after they observed us approach, I saw multiple people run into El Atoron which is located at 1428 W Lincoln Ave. Upon approaching El Atoron, we observed two women who appeared to be arguing and trying to fight each other. After both parties appear to have seperated, we requested multiple Spanish translators to help build a picture of what occurred at the location.

PO MARTIN spoke to one of the females that were involved in the altercation. She was identified as Evelin LOPEZ-GARCIA (1/17/2001 F/H), who stated that she was bartender at this location. She further stated that she and another women, who she only gave the first name of Gabriela, were fighting over one of the men in the bar.

I spoke to licensed premise owner Everardo GUTIERREZ-GARNICA (06/09/1982 W/M). They stated he did not have any involvement with what occurred outside and inside the business, stating that the two females had isolated issues not pertaining to the business itself. The business was *cooperative* with the investigation, the owner gave lots of information on what occurred and gave all his information. There were no security guards located at this business.

There was one individual that was later found and identified as Ismail COLORADO (8/2/2002 M/H) that had a laceration to the left side of his head. He stated that he had been hit in the head with a chair while at El Atoron. Bell Ambulance transported COLORADO to St. Francis. COLORADO stated that he did not wish to press charges. COLORADO stated that he did not know who had hit him in the head due to a large group fighting. He stated that once he was struck he left the business in attempt to flee the altercation.

There was no security surveillance gathered at this time.

While on scene, I observed the licenses posted and they were up to date.

There was no information or any casings found that involved the shotspotter that we were originally dispatched to.
