Dear Ms. Pica Fuentes:

This is to notify you that on Tuesday, September 10, 2024, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council renewal with a 72 (seventy-two) day suspension held in abeyance of the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report, applicant and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to health, safety or welfare of the public; for the premises located at 2000 S 13th St. ("Punta Cana").

On September 13, 2024, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses in which the Committee recommended renewal with a 72 (seventy-two) day suspension held in abeyance of the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report, applicant and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to health, safety or welfare of the public. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting on Tuesday, September 24, 2024 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee, you did not appear in person and you were not represented by a counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted to not renew the renewal with a 72 (seventy-two) day suspension held in abeyance of the Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report, applicant and aldermanic testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to health, safety or welfare of the public.


