To Whom It May Concern::

I am writing to document our claim against the City of Milwaukee for damages sustained to our property located at 1445 N. 5th Street. On May 31, 2006, MJ Construction while working on a City-let water contract, severely damaged our property by accidentally drilling through our hollow sidewalk. In the process, our sidewalk was destroyed, the structural support was weakened and our main water line was damaged. Hein Electric was completely innocent and without fault in this incident and, therefore, hold the city completely responsible for these repairs.

Enclosed are three documents from Sidello Property Services: 1) Invoice #8213 dated August 28, 2006, for engineering work (already performed) to inspect and design a plan for structural sidewalk repairs, 2) Proposal to properly repair the sidewalk, rectify any structural damages and reconnect electrical ground and 3) Proposal to properly repair the water main. Based on these documents, we are formally making a claim against the City of Milwaukee for \$27,825.00.
