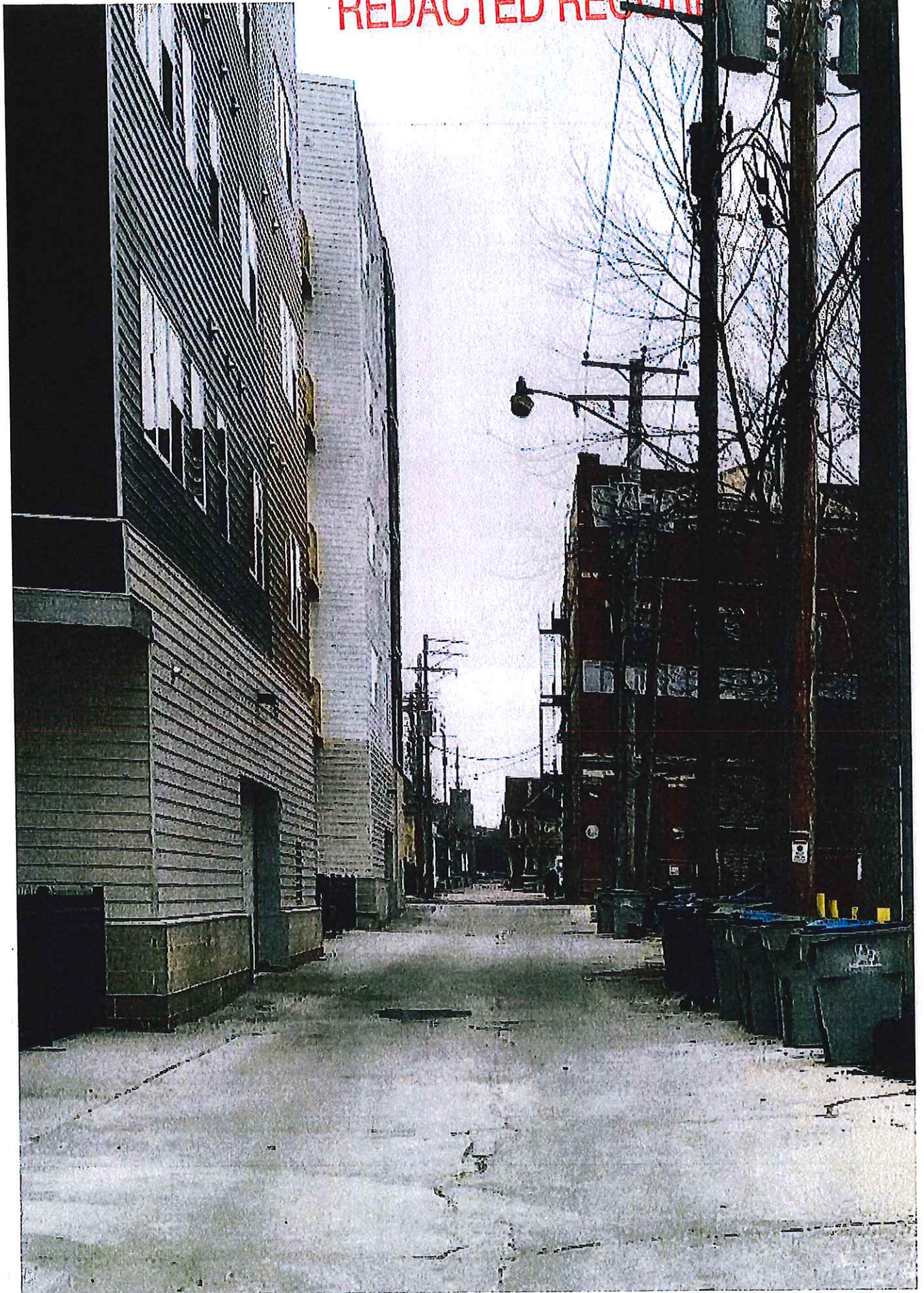
Please let me know what else we can do to resolve this issue. We are happy to do our part to keep Walker's Point clean and orderly!

This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 02/28/22 at 1:48pm., Milwaukee Police conducted follow up at 1006 S. Barclay St., regarding thefts of City owned Brass Vacuum Breaker valves. The officer was showed the area where valves that were brought in were kept and did not observe any City owned valves. The officer provided the employee with a photo of said valves. The employees were cooperative with the investigation.
2. On 03/18/22 at 3:02pm., Milwaukee Police conducted follow-up at 1006 S. Barclay., regarding a recovered stolen vehicle. The manager stated they only check junked vehicle's for liens and do not check for stolen. The manager provided the officer with the Junk Vehicle Bill of Sale as well as the photo ID of the seller. Initially the manager refused to turn the vehicle over to the owner stating it was a civil matter, however, eventually did agree to release the vehicle to the owner.
3. On 04/07/22, at 10: 00a.m, Milwaukee Police along with Department of Transportation Investigators, conducted follow-up at 1006 S. Barclay., regarding vehicle's with active liens that had GPS, that were tracked to Mill Valley Yard. Officers were not able to locate the vehicle's in question, however, did locate three different vehicles with active liens. The Department of Transportation Investigator requested copies of the paperwork for the transactions, however, was told the paperwork was misplaced. The owner was on scene and was advised of the violations.

4. On 04/22/22 at 12:00p.m., Milwaukee Police along with a Department of Transportation Investigator, conducted follow-up at 1006 S. Barclay., regarding the previous violation on 04/07/22, in which the three vehicles with active liens. The three vehicles had now been scrapped despite incomplete documentation and third-party interest not consenting to the scrapping of these vehicles. The owner was on scene and advised of the violations and the need to use Department of Transportation sites to conduct transactions for more accuracy. The owner was cited for 3 counts of Operating regulations/ Regulated Property, City Ordinance 93-43-5.

5. On 06/08/22 at 1:30p.m., Milwaukee Police along with DNS Inspectors conducted follow-up at 1006 S. Barclay., regarding complaints of the business purchasing stolen junked cars with no titles and catalytic converters. The owner was on scene and the traffic back-up as well as trash concerns were brought to his attention. The owner denied the trash build-up was from his business. The owner was showed pictures of traffic backing up due to his business and the officer requested he have vehicles enter the yard via a different route to eliminate the problem. The owner replied he will see what he can do.
6. On 10/19/22 at 11:32a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted follow-up at 1006 S. Barclay for a recovered stolen vehicle. On arrival officers met with the vehicle owner, who stated the dealership was able to locate her vehicle using a GPS tracker. The lien holder had a GPS tracker in the vehicle and had called the business to advise them the vehicle was stolen and had a lien on it. The lien holder stated approximately 22 minutes after the phone call, the GPS tracker stopped tracking. The lien holder stated they believed this vehicle was crushed even after being told they were in possession of a stolen vehicle with a lien.

The owner was on scene and provided the officer with a Department of Transportation run off showing the vehicle was not stolen and no lien in Wisconsin. The owner advised the officer that all they need is a Bill of Sale, Proof of no Lien and Photo Identification to purchase vehicles. The owner did provide officers with the tow truck driver's information. The officer contacted the tow truck driver who provided the officer with the photo id of the seller, who resides in the same apartment building as the victim. The tow truck driver stated the seller did not have a title or keys and stated they were both lost, and the vehicle wasn't drivable, that was the reason for the sale.

This Report submitted by Officer Carlos Felix assigned to Squad 2742 at the License Investigation Unit, Day Shift.

On Wednesday, February 28, 2022 at 1:48 PM I conducted follow up at 1006 S. Barclay St. (Mill Valley Recycling) regarding a theft complaints 22-020-0063 and 22-042-0077. These theft were of several City owned brass Vacuum Breaker valves.

Upon arrival at the business I made contact with office manager Isela Valdez. I advised Valdez of the thefts and showed her a photos of a valve, and I gave her a copy to keep. Valdez stated, she does not see what items are brought in to be recycled. Her interaction is at the pay desk when a ticket is brought in after that person has been at the scale. Transactions are recorded by the security system and entered into NEWPRS by FTP Voyager a recording system. Valdez called in a second employee to show me the container with the brass items that were brought in for recycling.

A male employee walked me into an area that had a large square cardboard container approximately four foot by four foot and four foot tall. I looked into the container as he moved some items around. I did observe several valves, but none that appeared to be the vacuum breaker valves stolen from the City. The male told me that it takes around one month before the container is filled and ready to be shipped out.

At the time of this follow up, the employees I had contact with were cooperative and willing to help.

That was the end of the follow up and this report.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by Police Officer (P.O.) Julius TORRES, assigned to Squad 2236, at District Two, on Early Power Shift with P.O. Waseem SAROSH.

On Friday, March 18th,2022 at 3:02 P.M., Squad 2236 was conducting follow up regarding the recovered stolen auto at Mill Valley Recycling located at 1006 S. Barclay St which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI. This incident was captured on Axon Body Worn camera.

I spoke with the on site manager, Robert A. TEICH (W/M, 10-05-1959) regarding the stolen vehicle in his lot that was recovered a day earlier. TEICH stated he located all the paperwork regarding the transaction of this vehicle. TEICH stated that the vehicle was sold them as a junk vehicle and towed to their facility by their tow truck. TEICH stated it is their standard procedure to take a copy of the sellers identification card and well as a picture of the seller holding the identification card next to their face. TEICH stated that they also complete a Junk Vehicle Bill of Sale (Form MV2459) with the seller's signature. TEICH provided me with the bill of sale for the vehicle which was dated (03-14-2022). The bill of sale was filled out with the following individuals information Keonte D. MCGHEE (B/M, 10-07-1997). TEICH was also able to provide me with a photocopy of the MCGHEE's Driver License and a photo of MCGHEE holding his D.L. up to his face. TEICH stated that they only check the vehicles sold to them for liens and do not check to determine if the vehicle is stolen.

TEICH initially refused to released the vehicle to the owner stating that it was a civil matter between the owner and the seller but he did later agree to release the vehicle to the listed owner.

This concludes my supplemental report.

Barclay Street. The Consumer Protection Investigators that were on scene are John Kleinfeltd, Maura Schifalacqua, Adam Kramer, and Jim Bartnik.

The inspection was generated after Kleinfeltd received a complaints of two vehicles with third party title liens being tracked to the Mill Valley Yard. Both vehicles were equipped with Global Positioning Systems (GPS). The vehicles in question were never located and not able to be tracked by GPS anymore. During the inspection three different vehicles were discovered to have active title liens on them. Two of the liens were in regards to child support and one was a title loan.

On Thursday April 21, 2022 at 12:00PM I along with Department Of Transportation, Consumer Protection Investigator John Kleinfeldt conducted follow up at 1006 S. Barclay Street, Mill Valley Recycling.

The follow up was in regards to an inspection conducted on April 7, 2022 (case# 220970561). During that inspection three vehicles were located on the property and in the process of being scrapped. The vehicles a 2005 Pontiac bearing VIN number1G2NE95M105881, 2002 Ford Explorer VIN Number 1FMZ473E92ZA52975, and a 1996 Chevy pickup 1500 Vin Number 2GCEK19R9T1251910. All three vehicles were processed and scrapped. Robert A. Teich was advised by Kleinfeldt that there were active title liens on all three.

On the 21st Kleinfeldt and I sat and spoke with Teich. He was advised by Kleinfeldt that the Department Of Transportation was issuing him a warning letter for not complying with State Statute and scraping three vehicles not cleared from liens. I personally served Teich citation **0683713B07**, **0683713B08**, and **0683713B09** for violating City Ordinance 93-43-5 (Operating Regulations / Regulated Property). The documentation for the three vehicles did not provide information that the seller was the legal owner and there was a third party interest in the property that did not consent to the scraping of the vehicles.

Kleinfeldt and I sat with Teich for approximately an hour as he discussed how his business uses a company known as Auto Data Direct (ADD) to check for vehicle liens as he is only required to do. The ADD reports Teich provided did not show any active liens. Kleinfeldt and I advised Teich that he should be using the Department Of Transportation site to conduct the lien checks and possibly another source to check a vehicle to confirm it is not stolen before conducting a transaction.

Teich was advised that both Kleinfeldt and I we are willing to assist him and his staff if they have any questions or concerns.

Three photos documenting the transactions of the three vehicles are attached to this report.

That ended the follow up and this report.

On June 6,2022 I was part of a chain email complaint from Alderman Jose Perez's office. The complaint stated the following:

"President Pérez has asked to share (I will keep Anonymous) email with you. There have been other complaints that were made over the weekend on our voicemail with no call back numbers. Complaints stated that Mill Valley Recycling is purchasing stolen cars as junk cars with no titles and also catalytic converters".

" License: Can you please place this email on the file".

"DNS & MPD: Can you please look into this matter".

A second email stated the following with attached photos:

"Hi all, I just stopped over to check on our property and this is what I saw at 1:40 pm today. This can't continue like this. It's like this every single day here. Please help me".

I had a phone conversation with DNS Supervisor Jason Golec regarding the complaints and other concerns that we were made aware of in regards to Mill Valley. After the conversation Golec stated he would make arrangements for an inspector to meet me at Mill Valley.

On June 8, 2022 at 1:30 PM I followed up with DNS Inspectors Gary Armstrong and Vincent Cortez at Mill Valley. Robert Teich, the business agent was on scene during the inspection. I explained to Robert that there was a complaint which came into the Alderman's Office and the DNS Inspectors and I were there to investigate it. Cortez showed Robert photos of vehicles stopped along the curb side on South First Street entering Mill Valley.

Robert stated, he has employees maintain the area and there is no trash generated by his business. Robert pointed to a neighboring scrap yard that he believed the trash complaint could be about. He explained the traffic generated on First street is part of his business having rush hours and compared it to traffic generated by McDonalds.

I asked Robert, during peak times could he have vehicles enter the yard off of S. Barclay Street to relieve the traffic backup on South First street, which is a major thoroughfare and blocks a County Bus stop located at the corner. Robert replied, he will try to see what he can do.

This report is written by PO Eric Robillard assigned to District 2 early power shift quad 2245.

On 10/19/2022 at 11:32 am I, along with my partner PO Brian Heder responded to Mill Valley located at 1006 S Barclay St, located in the City and County of Milwaukee for a recovered stolen vehicle.

Upon arrival the victim Tyshika ATLAS stated to me that her Dealership in Michigan where she had purchased the vehicle was able to locate her stolen vehicle using a GPS tracker. The vehicle was located but had already been crushed. I observed the victim's red Chevy cobalt crushed and on top of a stack of crushed salvaged vehicles.

We spoke with Robert TEICH (10-05-1959) the owner of Mill Valley Salvage. TEICH provided us with the paperwork they had for the Chevy Cobalt, which had a Wisconsin DOT run off showing the vehicle as not stolen and no lien on the vehicle in Wisconsin. Also in the paperwork was the photo ID of the tow truck driver Francisco ARECHIGA-AVILA (11-13-1985) who sold the vehicle. TEICH advised us that all they need is a bill of sale, photo identification and proof of no lien on a vehicle to purchase it.

The vehicle does however have a Lien through the Michigan dealership where it was purchased for \$6,000.00. The dealership Champion Auto Sales (6197 Clio Road, Mount Morris, MI 48458 ph#810-789-7600) had GPS tracking on the vehicle and that is how it was located there by the victim. I spoke with Drew DICE a representative of the dealership by phone. At 8:47 am (9:47am Michigan time) on 10/19/2022. DICE stated that he called Mill Valley and informed them that they had a stolen vehicle with which they had a lien on that was showing to be at their location. At 9:09 am (10:09 am Michigan time) on 10/19/2022 the GPS tracker stopped working and it is believed this is when the vehicle was crushed even after being informed they were in possession of a stolen vehicle with a Lien through his company. According to GPS monitoring the vehicle first showed the ping at 1006 S Barclay St. on 10/18/2022 at 2:22 pm. The vehicle GPS shows 18 hours and 47

minutes between when it first pinged at Mill Valley to when it stopped functioning.

We then contacted the tow Driver by phone who met us at District 2 to speak. The driver Francisco ARECHIGA-AVILA stated his company (Mr. Green Towing) purchased the vehicle from a Desmond SHULER (b/m 8-8-2001) at the address of 1130 N 29th st, which is the victim's apartment building. SHULER provided him a photo ID which ARECHIGA-AVILA states matched the person he was speaking with in person at the time. SHULER had a bill of sale for the vehicle as well as the registration paperwork for the vehicle. SHULER did not have the vehicle title or keys and stated to ARECHIGA-AVILA that he had lost the keys and that the vehicle does not work which is why he was salvaging it. ARECHIGA-AVILA paid SHULER \$200.00 for the vehicle and towed it. On 10-18-2022 ARECHIGA-AVILA received \$270.00 from Mill Valley for the salvage.
