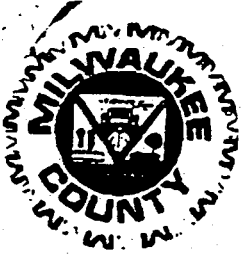

Dear Chief Jones:

On July 26, 1999, City of Milwaukee Police Officer Jeffrey Kranz shot and killed Arthur L. Cohee Jr. in the City of Milwaukee.

The purpose of this letter is to advise you and other interested parties of the results of the investigation of that event by the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office. That investigation was conducted by District Attorney E. Michael McCann and Assistant District Attorney Derek C. Mosley. That investigation involved a review of the testimony given at an inquest that was held on October 27 and 28, 1999, and the verdict rendered by the jury at the conclusion of the inquest, personal interviews of persons who had information concerning the above incident, a review of the official City of Milwaukee Police Department reports, an examination of the area where the incident occurred, and an examination of the physical evidence.

It is the decision of the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office that Officer Jeffrey Kranz will not be charged with violating any provision of the Wisconsin criminal law. That decision is based upon the finding, consistent with the inquest verdict, that the acts of
