Regarding: Jewel-Osco liquor license application at 709
East Capitol Drive

As part of the liquor license application process, the Riverwest Neighborhood Association has elected to withdraw the covenant made with Jewel-Osco related to the proposed liquor store at their East Capitol Drive location. We recognize that our covenant with Jewel-Osco has no place in current proceedings in the face of overwhelming neighborhood opposition and very limited actual support for the license.

Our responsibility, first and foremost as a neighborhood association is to be a credible representative voice for our community in matters that impact us collectively. Our credibility has been tested and compromised in this situation. At a neighborhood meeting on the evening of May 7 hosted by Alderman Mike D'Amato and County Supervisor Willie Johnson in conjunction with RNA, neighbors made compelling arguments to oppose the license. The license committee has been presented those arguments. In an up or down vote held that night, the overwhelming majority of people in attendance voted to oppose the license including some RNA members that worked on the covenant. We then went through a consensus building process to decide the best course to take with regard to the covenant itself. By the end of the process there was consensus in the room to withdraw the covenant.

We want license committee members to know we operated in good faith with Jewel Osco and we believe they did the same. We will continue to pursue covenants with other liquor licensees in our community.

We thank for your attention to this matter.

56 people in attendance**

I. History of Issue by Alderman D'Amato

Jewel-Osco applied for its initial liquor license in 1998. It was held indefinitely until recently when its attorney told the City it had to hear the license before the Utilities and Licenses Committee.

Earlier this year the members of the Riverwest Neighborhood Association met with the attorney for Jewel-Osco and created a covenant. The covenant, (enclosed) included guidelines for a gentleman's agreement that Jewel-Osco would not sell certain products, reduce the size of the liquor store to 2400 feet, and sell Riverwest products in its store. The covenant was signed by the RNA and Jewel and presented to the Utilities and Licenses Committee at a hearing on April 8, 2002.

Several neighbors who had not been involved in creating the covenant, in immediate proximity to the store came to testify at the hearing on April 8th. Those neighbors were highly opposed to the liquor license. It was decided that a neighborhood meeting should be held to further discuss the issue and then at a later date only Alderman D'Amato and a representative for Jewel-Osco would be allowed to testify.

Alderman D'Amato went over the agenda for the meeting and made a change as requested by the neighbors.

A representative from Jewel-Osco was invited to attend but was by no means required to attend. Alderman D'Amato asked if a representative was present and there was no response.

**Mark Lawson
922 E. Center St.**

Asked if the store at North and Humboldt had applied for a liquor license. Alderman D'Amato responded that he did not believe that they had applied, however, that is not in his district so he would not have been notified if they had.

Jonas Karvelis

3222 N. Cambridge Ave.

Asked about the dates of the hearing before Utilities and Licenses and the Common Council. Alderman D'Amato responded that the U&L hearing was to be May 21, 2002 and would be taken to the Council on June 4th. (Since that time we have learned that due to a conference out of town, two committee members and Alderman D'Amato will be gone. The meeting has been tentatively re-scheduled for May 28th).

II. The Co-Chairs of the Riverwest Neighborhood Association were invited to present their views of the issue.

Shawn Smart

2104 N. Booth St.

Shawn went over the covenant (attached) and reiterated that covenant did not intend to show any kind of support for the license. It was a neutral covenant that indicated that if the license were granted the restrictions included should be followed. They, in fact, took out all language that implied support. She then read the covenant aloud to all in attendance.

George Singleton

2834 N. Fratney St.

He stated that he did not support the liquor license for Jewel-Osco. He stated that the RNA covenant was based on a similar covenant for a store on 35th and North. He also reported that Bella Luna pasta was in the store last month, Lakefront Brewery products were in other Jewel-Osco stores, as is Ma Bensch's products.

Questions were then allowed of the RNA rep.

Tom Collin

3429 N. Bremen St.

Asked what the introductory language to the covenant read. The introductory language was read aloud to Mr. Collin.

Pat Moore

1120 E. Auer Ave.

Did Jewel-Osco go back on their word that they would not ask for a liquor license? Had they ever stated that they would not seek a liquor license? Did they originally agree not to sell liquor in their store? He was told that the answer was no. They never stated that they would not seek a liquor license at the Capitol store.

Rozeanne Screven
3357 N. Humboldt Blvd.

Was there a time limit set in the covenant? The answer to that is no. The covenant is a gentleman's agreement that was understood to be for perpetuity.

George Fluharty
3278 N. Humboldt Blvd.

What do you say to those people who believe that the covenant is interpreted as supportive of the liquor license? **George Singleton** responded that they told Jewel-Osco in September that they did NOT support a liquor license. **Shawn Smart** stated that those who were known by the RNA to oppose the license were contacted about the license and there was no groundswell of opposition that arose from any of the neighbors so the RNA decided to go forward with drafting the covenant.

Shawn Smart stated that she did not think that there would be a covenant if everyone had communicated with each other better.

Kim Kosmitis
2459 N. Pierce St.

Asked if this store would be selling different products than the East Pointe Pick-n-Save. He pointed out that there is no covenant there. The covenant seems as if it would hamper business.

Juan Carlos Ruiz
2457 N. Booth St.

Asked if there had been any outreach to the Latino community to notify them about the license. Also asked how granting this liquor license would help strengthen the community. **Shawn Smart** responded that there were several Latinos on their email list and their mailing list. They did the best they could with the information that they had. If you go to one RNA meeting you are on the mailing list for life.

III. Representatives from the 3400 blocks of Fratney, Weil, and Bremen are given their opportunity to speak on the license. (Amy Weisbrot and Rosemary Oliviera)

Amy Weisbrot
3426 N. Fratney

Thanked everyone for coming. She acknowledged the hard work of the RNA and stressed the importance of Riverwest having a united front on this issue. She noted that the Capitol Drive area had 3 times the criminal activity than the other grocery stores with liquor sales in the area. (See attached crime data) She cited a direct correlation between increased crime and proximity to liquor stores. She also noted that she did not know that Jewel was going before U&L until she read an article in the paper. After reading that information she began to go door to door in the neighborhood to measure support or opposition. She noted that there was significant opposition.

Rosemary Oliveira
3278 N. Humboldt Blvd.

She is opposed to the covenant. She would like to vote to withdraw the covenant. Said covenant is dangerous, meaningless, and Jewel-Osco would sell the local products even without it. She also stated that she believed that Jewel-Osco would ignore the covenant anyway. She also complained that the parking lot is a mess, despite the fact that when at the hearing Jewel-Osco seemed embarrassed that it was so messy. They are bad neighbors and do not deserve the privilege of a liquor license.

The floor was then opened for questions.

Cathy Kaye
3477 N. Fratney St.

She asked Amy to explain the crime stats and their significance. Amy Weisbrot told her that poverty and unemployment were high in their area and that there was a direct correlation between crime and liquor. (See enclosed crime data)

Amy Weisbrot
3426 N. Fratney St.

People are already drinking in the parking lot behind the Jewel on Humboldt and there isn't even a liquor store there. People would buy liquor and drink in Estabrook Park. The 3500-3800 blocks of Fratney are already a scary corridor and a liquor store would increase loitering, and public drinking. There were also issues with litter, and she feels that 2400 square feet is just too big. This would mean less space for groceries, and healthy food.

Rozeanne Screvin
3357 N. Humboldt Blvd.

Asked if the covenant could be rescinded. Response was that yes, they could vote on that tonight.

Shawn Smart reiterated that the RNA is a consensus-building group. Admitted that the process failed this time and that she would like Alderman D'Amato to see the show of support that existed for rescinding the covenant.

John Lindquist
3433 N. Fratney St.

He showed the audience two hypodermic needles that were found in an alley behind a neighbor's house. He stated that we just don't need the liquor store. They live in a great neighborhood that goes through periods of crisis. It is up and down. It would most certainly go down with more places to buy liquor. There are currently 43 places to buy alcohol in Riverwest (Capitol to North, River to Holton) They just don't need any more. Would rather support local businesses.

Sura Faraj
3029A N. Booth St.

Clarified Juan Carlos' position against the liquor license.

Kim Kosmitis
2459 N. Pierce St.

Would like people to know that he supports the license. Continued on to give a free market argument for issuing the license to Jewel-Osco. He also stated that the covenant was blackmail and that they should not be denied a liquor license because of the economic conditions in the area. Everyone should have access to a liquor store no matter what their economic standing.

Judy Swanson
3446 N. Weil St.

There are many liquor outlets on Holton Street. There is no shortage of opportunity to buy liquor. Stated that the group is not prejudice toward one group or another, just doesn't want the license. (In response to Kim Kosmitis' statement) Also stated that her husband is an eyewitness to people drinking in the Jewel-Osco parking lot right now without the store there.

County Supervisor Willie Johnson, Jr.
3869 N. Humboldt Blvd. #206

He stated that he has knocked on a lot of doors in Riverwest and has seen the crime in the neighborhood. He feels it is not a good idea for liquor license to be issued for the sake of the children in the neighborhood and the overall health and safety of its citizens. He is against the license.

Steve Chojnacki
3480 N. Fratney St.

Some bars in Riverwest have closed. He had an understanding with previous alderman that if one tavern closed a new one would not open. He stated that we need to stop liquor stores and taverns from growing. He also stated that Jewel-Osco does not run a good business.

Claudine Lienau
2978 N. Pierce St.

She lives on the border of district 3 and district 6. She feels that there is a disconnection between the north and south ends of Riverwest. RW needs to be more cohesive and stick together. Shouldn't rely on other people to tell them what is going on in their neighborhood. She opposed issuing the liquor license to Jewel-Osco.

Jonas Carvellis

3222 N. Cambridge Ave.

Will the RW vote tonight have any impact on the Utilities and Licenses Committee? Alderman D'Amato responded that everything that happened at the meeting tonight would be passed on to the Utilities and Licenses Committee. Mr. Karvellis also asked if they should submit letters and pictures. Alderman D'Amato said that would be fine. Mr. Karvellis then asked if the full council would uphold the decision of the committee. Alderman D'Amato responded that it is rare for the council to go against the decision of the committee.

Becky Rabatin

532 E. Garfield

She asked if they should vote up or down on the license and keep the covenant in place in case JO was granted the license or if they should vote up or down on both.

IV. Voting

Voting occurs after some discussion about what they would be voting on...to rescind the covenant or oppose the license or both.

50 people stated that they would be voting.

23 people stated that they learned of the meeting because of the letter Alderman D'Amato sent in the mail.

10 people stated that they learned of the meeting because of the efforts of the residents in the 3400 blocks of Fratney and Weil.

12 people stated that they had learned of the meeting because of the notice from the Riverwest Neighborhood Association and the **Riverwest Currents** newspaper.

29 people stated that they had at some point shopped at Jewel-Osco.

6 people stated that they were *regular* Jewel-Osco shoppers.

RNA voted 49 to 1 in opposition to the license. 49 people against, 1 for.

After discussion about the process, RNA came to a decision through the consensus process and unanimously rescinded the covenant.

Regarding the development of a Jewel-Osco liquor store at the 709 E. Capitol Drive location, the Riverwest Neighborhood Association takes the following position:

- Proposed sizing – 2,400 square feet or less.

Community Impact of Granting a Liquor License to Jewel-Osco on Capitol

There are numerous reasons for the widespread opposition to the Jewel-Osco (309 East Capitol) application for a liquor license. This Riverwest Jewel-Osco is proposing to install a 2400 square foot liquor outlet. It would be one of the two largest outlets in the northeast side. This mega-liquor outlet would be detrimental to the Riverwest community.

There is substantial research showing the link between liquor outlets and increased crime in low-income neighborhoods. According to Dr. Richard Block, a Chicago sociologist and specialist on crime, "There are different kinds of relationship between liquor retail outlets and crime depending on density and types of neighborhood. In neighborhoods with high crime rates, particularly those near an expressway outlet, liquor outlets with carry-out service and large parking lots, create additional opportunities to commit crimes, especially in the parking lot." (See *Space, Place and Crime* by Dr. Richard Block).

Eastbrook Park

The Riverwest Jewel Osco on East Capitol serves a target population in census tract 44. This census tract is a lower-income community where unemployment is approximately 14% and one in four persons live in poverty. These rates are far higher than in the census areas where other large stores are located.

high unemployment & poverty rate

Poverty and unemployment are highly correlated to crime rates. This is evident when comparing the crimes reported in the East Capitol Jewel Osco (44) area compared to the census tracts where Gold's Pick and Save (Tract 113), Kohl's on Van Buren (143) and the Jewel-Osco on North and Humboldt. The differences are startling.

The existing rate of crime reports in the Jewel-Osco tract on East Capitol is extremely high – twice as high as Gold's Pick and Save, three times as high as the Jewel Osco on North and Humboldt and four times as high as the Kohl's on Van Buren. It is interesting to note that the poverty and unemployment rates are second highest in tract 113, corresponding to the second highest crime rate and lowest in tract 143 where crime is also lowest.

Opening a liquor mega-store in a community where unemployment, poverty and crime are already very high would create a substantial risk factor in a neighborhood working to build stability and increase safety for the hundreds of families with children who live here. This does not make good sense or good public policy.
