Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

## Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.



This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Early Shift Community Prosecution Unit. On Saturday, January 16, 2015, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to St. Mary's Hospital to investigate a report of a shooting.

The victim in this offense initially gave a false account of the incident, stating that he had sustained the gunshot wound at another location. The victim later stated that he and a second subject had been inside of Exotica (2724 S 13<sup>th</sup>) and that he had stepped on another patron's shoe causing the patron to become very upset. The victim stated that his party left the premises and were followed by a group of males, one of which discharged a firearm into the vehicle he was inside of, striking him in the left arm and causing damage to the vehicle. Evidence form the incident was later recovered outside of the premises. Video evidence from the exterior of the premises was recovered; however, the video recording from the "I.D. Scanner" was not functional the day of the incident.

I was unable to locate any calls for service at or around the premises regarding a "Fight" or "Shots fired" from 01/16/15.

On Monday, January 18, 2016, at or about 1:45 am, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premises for a "Wanted Subject" when a security officer for the premises, Melissa Y FREYTES, stated that the subject who committed the shooting was inside of the tavern. The subject left the premises prior to the arrival of the officers but FREYTES did provide information regarding the suspect's vehicle and video was recovered regarding the suspect.

It should be noted that FREYTES stated that the licensee, Israel CAMPO (M/W 11/18/72), had called her at home to inform her that the subject wanted for the shooting was inside of the premises and that she then had to travel to the tavern where she called for police.

I did speak with the licensee regarding the incident by phone on Monday, January 18, 2016, at or about 12:20 pm. OCAMPO stated that he had been insid eof the premises during the incident, but that he had not heard the gunshots and that no involved in the incident nor any of the patrons or employees had made him aware of the incident.

### 1 NARRATIVE SECTION:

This report is written by P.O. Marco Lopez, assigned to District Two, Late shift.

On the night of Saturday, June 7th, 2015, at approximately 3:26AM a fight started across the street of the tavern, located at 2725 S. 13<sup>th</sup> St. Security working observed several males fighting, and once they dispersed they observed a man laying in the middle of the street. They called police and brought the man inside, to render aid. At the same time another incident and a subject, later identified as Tariq I. Abdullah (b/m, 07/22/1986) became unruly with security during bar close. Security was forced to decentralize the Abdullah and place him in handcuffs. My investigation was filed under MPD IR# 15-158-0023 as a Disorderly Conduct report and Abdullah was placed under police custody.

On Saturday, June 7th, 2015 I conducted an interview of the Tavern owner, who identified himself to me as Israel Ocampo (w/m, 11/17/1972). He allowed me access to the camera system, which all appeared to work properly. Video was unable to capture the fight that occurred across the streeet. I conducted interviews of various employees, including the night club's, Security officers. Officer statements indicate that the second incident was with a reacurring patron, Abdullah, to which they have had several problems with in the past.

This report is written by P.O. Kevin VODICKA assigned to District Two, Early Shift Community Prosecution Unit. On Wednesday, September 30, 2015, at or about 5:09 pm, Squads 2212 (SGT. Tracy TABIADON) and 2268 (P.O. Kevin VODICKA) conducted a licensed premises check at Exoticas The Club, located at 2724 S 13th St specifically regarding the replacement of the exterior surveillance cameras and a possibly unreported incident of "Shots Fired" into the premises. It should be noted that the hours of operation for the premises are Sunday 10:00 am – 2:00 am and Monday – Saturday 7:00 am – 2:00 am.

Officers arrived on-scene and observed cameras on the front exterior of the building and what appeared to be two bullet strikes on exterior west facing wall of the premises.

Officers then entered the unlocked premises to find four or five employees inside including a subject behind the bar, identified by WI DL as Janicemarie TORRES (F/W 06/30/94) of 3416 S 24th St Milwaukee, WI 53215. TORRES stated that she possessed a City of Milwaukee Class "D" license but was it was not on her person at the time. I then spoke with a subject who identified himself as the "manager in training", Ricardo C VALENTIN (M/W 08/02/92) of 3139 N Holton St. VALENTIN stated that he was in the process of obtaining both his Class "D" and "M" licenses and that he and fellow employees were preparing the V.I.P. room for the evening.

VALENTIN stated that the exterior cameras had been upgraded and showed me that the four exterior cameras were now functional.

Regarding the bullet strikes, VALENTIN stated that a firearm related incident had occurred two to three months prior in the 1300 block of W Cleveland Ave where two bullets had struck the premises. VALENTIN stated that officers had spoken to him during the investigation. VALENTIN was cooperative during the course of the investigation.

I did observe seven contaminated liquor bottles (fruit flies), which VALENTIN subsequently disposed of. A check of department records revealed an "Endangering Safety by use of a Deadly Weapon" investigation at 2674 S 13th St on 06/24/15 where 12 bullet casings of two different calibers were recovered; however, no damage to the surrounding buildings is described and neither the CAD nor the report mention the premises. A check with LIRA on 10/18/15 confirmed that VALENTIN had applied for both a Class "M" and "D" license, but neither had been issued. There was record of Janicemarrie TORRES currently or previously holding a Class "D" or "M" license.

The listed agent, Israel CAMPOS (M/W 11/18/72) was issued a citation for responsible person on premises required.

This report is written by PO Eliel CONTRERAS assigned to District 2, Late Power Shift.

On Sunday, 10-19-15 at approximately 12:42am Squad 2464 (PO TAZAMISHIA LEFLORE and I) responded to Exoticas The Club (2724 S 13<sup>th</sup> St) for Follow Up. The purpose of my follow up was to drop of a citation to the Licensee, Israel OCAMPO (W/M 11-18-72), for ordinance violation 90-8-1 (Responsible Person Upon Licensed Premises).

Upon arriving on scene, I spoke with Ricardo C VALENTIN (W/M 8-2-92). I asked VALENTIN if OCAMPO was available and VALENTIN stated no. I asked VALENTIN if it would be possible to call OCAMPO and have him respond to my location and VALENTIN stated he would not be able to because OCAMPO was out of town. I asked VALENTIN what his position was at Exoticas and VALENTIN stated he was the manager. I asked VALENTIN if I could see his Class B Manager's License and he stated he was in the process of getting one. After VALENTIN informed me that he did not have his manager's license, I conducted a license premise check.

I proceeded to speak with the bartender, Takeyah Marie NORMAN (B/F 9-4-94). I asked NORMAN to show me her bartender's license and NORMAN informed me that she was in the process of also getting her license.
