Subject: Sewer Maintenance Fund Follow-up Items

Alderwoman Coggs,

This email is a follow-up to your requests for additional information at the budget hearings last week for the Sewer Maintenance Fund.

You had asked for expanded diversity information based on professional level. That information is provided in the attached spreadsheet. The numbers differ slightly from the budget presentation due to the information being gathered at different points in time.

You had asked about the purchasing contract in the amount of \$500,931 that was highlighted in the LRB information packet, and whether that was competitively bid. This purchase is for a vacuum truck that we commonly use in Sewer Maintenance for sewer cleaning. While it is a sole source contract, the vendor was selected based on a competitive bid process performed by an entity called Sourcewell. Sourcewell is a State of Minnesota local government unit and service cooperative created under the laws of the State of Minnesota that offers cooperative procurement solutions to government entities. City of Milwaukee Fleet Services is a participant in Sourcewell. Sourcewell issued a public solicitation for Sewer Vacuum, Hydro-Excavation, and Municipal Pumping Equipment with Related Accessories and Supplies from which the vendor for our equipment was awarded a contract. Supporting documentation is attached.
