Here at Mosorec International Foundation we are not only committed to this initiative, but have verifiable evidence that we have the infrastructure in place for this to be an ongoing, strong, culturally, educationally, and economically beneficial relationship. As we look to the future of this alliance, we envision a growing awareness and appreciation of each other's culture and people.
