Dear Council Members:

We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, Anthony James, 2528 State Road 33, Port Washington, WI 53074, alleges that on April 14, 2008, he suffered losses to his concrete planters due to potholes on the ramp from West Appleton Avenue to West Silver Spring Drive.

Our investigation reveals the Infrastructure Services Division records indicate this section of roadway is under the jurisdiction of Milwaukee County. He may wish to contact the Milwaukee County Highway Engineer, 10320 Watertown Plank Road, Wauwatosa, WI 53226. Since this loss does not involve the City of Milwaukee, it cannot be held liable. Therefore, we recommend denial of this claim.
