I Gwendoly Perry wish to appeal the decision that was made April 28th 2022, for a claim that was made on December 14, 2021.

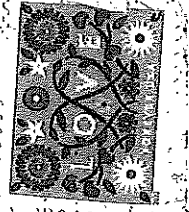

We are in receipt of your claim for damages to your vehicle that occurred on December 14, 2021, when you backed out of your driveway and into a City of Milwaukee sanitation truck.


Our investigation determined that a City of Milwaukee Sanitation crew operating a sanitation truck were stopped in front of 5468 North 27th Street, in order to empty the garbage carts. During the process of backing out of your driveway, you hit the back of the sanitation truck that was stopped in the street.

It is our view that you are the responsible party for any damages resulting from this incident. As such, the City of Milwaukee cannot accept liability in this case, and we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a written statement requesting a hearing within 21 days of the postmarked date of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202. Please include a photocopy of this letter's envelope, showing the postmark, and retain the original in the event further proof is needed.
