1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):  
The Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) is the fiscal agent for a multi-jurisdictional traffic safety task force comprised of MPD, Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office, University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee Police Department, and Marquette University Police Department. The task force is focused on decreasing traffic crashes, related fatalities and injuries, and obtaining voluntary compliance with traffic regulations. This grant will fund a High Visibility Enforcement campaign targeting speed and reckless driving violations enforcement from December 1, 2025 - September 2026.
2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:  
The Milwaukee Police Department created the Traffic Safety Unit (TSU) to address rampant reckless driving, speeding, and vehicular collisions. TSU utilizes High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) as a universal traffic safety approach designed to create deterrence and change unlawful traffic behaviors. HVE combines highly visible and proactive strategies that include law enforcement, education, and engineering solutions to create safer streets and neighborhoods in Milwaukee.
3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):  
The total grant award of \$81,256.16, with a grantor funded amount of \$65,004.93 (80%) and a local in-kind match of \$16,251.23 (20%), will fund police officer overtime for HVE deployments during enforcement periods from December 2025 - January 2026. The award breakdown includes MPD at \$65,004.93, MCSO at \$20,000, UWM at \$5,000, and Marquette University at \$5,000.
