5th Aldermanic District

Alley between W. Capitol Dr., W. Fiebrantz Ave., W. Fiebrantz Ct., N. 79th St., and N. 81st St. (ST212140101):

Concrete alley pavement reconstruction, replace some abutting walk or driveway approaches, grading, and storm drainage facilities where necessary.

7th Aldermanic District

W. Melvina St. – N. 27th St. to N. 30th St. (ST211130115):

Concrete pavement reconstruction, replace all curb and gutter, replace sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, sodding (5 – 7-foot width of tree border area), grading, and tree removal where necessary.

Alley between W. Brooklyn Pl., N. Norwood Pl., W. Roosevelt Dr., and N. 55th St. (N. Norwood Pl. entrance) (ST212130114):

Replace driveways and alley approaches as necessary.

8th Aldermanic District

W. Legion St. – S. 24th St. to S. Layton Blvd. (ST211120115):

Concrete pavement reconstruction, replace all curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches, sodding (0-foot width of tree border area), and grading.

9th Aldermanic District

N. 73rd St. – W. Calumet Rd. to W. Bradley Rd. (ST211130117):

Asphalt pavement resurfacing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway approaches where necessary, install new sidewalk as necessary, sodding (6-foot width of tree border area), and grading.

14th Aldermanic District

Alley between E. Fernwood Ave., S. Illinois Ave., S. Indiana Ave., and E. Oklahoma Ave. (ST212140129):

Concrete alley pavement reconstruction, replace some abutting walk or driveway approaches, grading, and storm drainage facilities where necessary.
