Dear Council Members:

Claimants, Raul and Maria Vargas, 1726 West Mallory Avenue, Milwaukee WI 53221, allege that on June 16, 2013 they sustained damages when a City sewer backed up into the basement of their residence. They claim damages in the amount of \$55,890.14.

The Infrastructure Services Division (ISD) records indicate that on June 16, 2013, Sewer Maintenance responded to a call of a backwater at 1726 West Mallory Avenue. They found the City main sewer to be clogged with grease. A sewer Jet Vac was used to open the clog, clean the sewer and restore it to proper working order. The ISD records also indicate that the sewer is on a regular cleaning schedule and was last cleaned, prior to this incident, on April 13, 2012. Because the sewer is on a regular cleaning schedule and the City did not have notice of problems with the sewer, the City cannot be held liable. Therefore, we recommend that this claim be denied.
