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Remarks

While en route to the emergency, B3 Weinkauf, monitored the fire ground frequency and dispatch frequency providing updates to both on scene companies and dispatcher pertinent to the incident.

1st Chief

B3 was positioned to not impede arrival and positioning of fire apparatus. Consideration was made toward the vehicle's use as a command post. B3, the 1st arriving Battalion Chief, initially functioned as both Operations and Command in accordance with NIMS guidelines and the MFD Incident Management Plan, handling all communications with dispatch upon the assumption of Command. B3 ensured that hazard zone personnel were operating safely throughout the incident and maintained communications with assigned crews while tracking crew location and function utilizing a standard command board. 2nd Chief

B10 vehicle was positioned to not impede arrival and positioning of fire apparatus. B10, the 2nd arriving Battalion Chief functioned as Command in accordance with NIMS guidelines and the MFD Incident Management Plan, assuming all communications with dispatch, non-hazard zone personnel, and outside agencies. Dispatch was updated regarding conditions, actions, needs, and expected working time for assigned units at regular intervals. B3 collaborated with the Operations Chief to ensure tactical benchmarks were completed. If additional resource needs became apparent, the Command Chief did transmit this and any specific staging information to Dispatch.

3rd Chief

B4 vehicle was positioned to not impede arrival and positioning of fire apparatus. B4, the Incident Safety Officer (ISO), wore full PPE along with a Safety vest and/or Safety tank cover. B4 as the ISO continually evaluated tactical safety and ensure that all members were performing their respective tasks in accordance with established safety procedures. B4 paid extra attention evaluating and isolated any wires down, ensured proper usage of PPE, evaluation of fire conditions and structural integrity, and evaluated potential for hazardous contents. All unsafe acts or risk that outweighed perceived benefit was stopped immediately and reported to the Operations Chief.

Upon arrival E23, first due, found a 2 and 1/2 wood frame boarded building with fire showing on second floor charlie side and went offensive. E23 layed a quick attack line to back door to enter rear stairway to second floor.
