There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 09/07/22 at 8:00pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 103 E. Keefe Avenue for a reckless use of a weapon complaint. Investigation revealed that a "problem customer" entered the store with a BB gun and shot at employee, striking him in the stomach, causing pain and discomfort. The incident was captured on video surveillance and the employees were extremely cooperative with police on scene.
2. On 10/16/22 at 3:51am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 103 E. Keefe Avenue for an entry complaint, which later resulted in a shooting investigation. Surveillance video depicted a subject breaking into the business and making his way into the enclosed counter. He then becomes alert that the applicant and another subject had entered the establishment. As the subject is attempting to exit the enclosure, he is shot by the subject who entered the store with the applicant. The subject is then struck several times with several blunt objects all over the body and is pinned down by the subject who shot him until police arrive.

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3. On 03/22/23, the applicant was cited at W. Keefe Ave., and N. Port Washington Ave., for Class A Premises Open After Hours.

4. On 04/29/23 at 10:02a.m., Milwaukee Police were assigned to work Wisconsin WINS, which checks area vendors for age compliant tobacco sales. This report is written by Police Officer Robert Lawrence, assigned to Milwaukee Police Department District Six (6), Early Shift, **Violent Crime Reduction Team (VCRT)**.

On Saturday, April 29th, 2023, at approximately **10:02AM**, Squad 6269 (myself) and to Public Safety Cadets (*Alejandrina Partida-Hernandez, White, Female, Date of Birth 08/28/2005 17 years of age*) and Edgar (MPD Cadet) conducted a compliance check at the location of **103 East Keefe Avenue in the City and County of Milwaukee (Keefe Food Mart)**. This was in partnership with the Memorandum Understanding with Community Advocates, Coalition Coordinator of the City of Milwaukee tobacco -Free Alliance, Charlie Leonard, Wisconsin Wins Campaign (WI WINS is an intervention program designed to help the state of Wisconsin come into and stay in compliance with requirements of the federal synar regulations). The two teens were trained in the WI WINS program protocol Saturday April 11th, 2023.

Investigation

Partida-Hernandez and Edgar entered the aforementioned location in an attempt to purchase tobacco products for sale. The goal was for the organization to request identification and turn the minors away after they found out they both were teens and ineligible to purchase the product. Partida-Hernandez requested the sale of a packet of Swisher Sweets Cigars Classic brand packages from the cashier who was later identified as *Judybir Singh (Middle Eastern Asian, Male, Date of Birth 08/30/1999)* Singh provided Partida-Hernandez with the aforementioned tobacco product and did not request identification. Partida-Hernandez paid cash and completed the sale. No receipt was given to Partida-Hernandez, Partida-Hernandez and Edgar returned to the meeting point and provided me with the description of the subject/cashier and the point of sale.

License Information and Citation

I then return to the Keefe Food Mart and spoke with Singh who was the only employee working at the time. Singh provided the license for the location which is hanging on the wall of the location and is as follows;

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 5/29/2024 at 10:05 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


