1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The grant is intended to be used for WNV surveillance which includes mosquito surveillance. The grant is through the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and is funneled through state health departments and then passed on to local health departments. The target locations of these funds are for urban areas.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

The project relates to the strategic goals of the Milwaukee Health Department by using vector surveillance to identify when WNV is present in the community so actions can be taken to help reduce the possibility of an increase in community disease,

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

The funds received by this grant will allow the Milwaukee Health Department to continue with mosquito surveillance in the City of Milwaukee. This is part of a three pronged approach to respond to WNV in the community. There are no negative impacts expected as a result of MHD's participation in this grant.
