2. On 03/09/2013 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a Property Damage complaint at 2078 South 8th Street (Quisquella Bar). Investigation revealed a customer left the bar and threw pieces of cinder block through the windows of the business. Milwaukee police incident report #130680013 filed.

3. On 10/09/2016 Milwaukee police responded to a battery/cutting at 2078 South 8th Street (The Quisquella Bar). An officer spoke to Security Guard Matthew Mikulance. Mikulance told the officer that a patron, who was bleeding from the face, had run from the bar stating he was attacked. Mikulance then identified a person standing in front of the bar as the owner. The officer approached this subject, later identified as Jordy Javier Laureano, and asked if the camera was working. Laureano yelled at the officer, telling him he had no name. When the officer told Laureano that he would be arrested if he did not provide the requested information, Laureano again yelled at the officer. When the officer attempted to detain Laureano, he resisted and placed his hand on a bulge located on the waistline of his right side. This bulge was later discovered to be a Ruger P95 semi-automatic firearm. While in the booking room, it was discovered that Laureano does possess a concealed weapons permit. PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by P.O. Anna OJDANA, assigned to District Two, Late Shift.

On Sunday, October 9, 2016 at 1:31 AM, Squad 2320 (P.O. MUNOZ and I) responded to a Battery Cutting call for service at 2078 S. 8Th St., The Quisquella Bar, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival I spoke with the Security Guard Matthew T. MIKULANCE (w/m, 04/26/82) who stated that he observed the victim ran out of the inside of the bar, saying he was attacked. MIKULANCE stated that he noticed the victim bleeding severly from his face, and stated that he wrestled with the suspect, after which the suspect fled in unknown direction.

During the interview MIKULANCE pointed to a male who was standing in front of the bar and informed us that he was the owner of the bar. P.O. MUNOZ walked over to the subject who was later identified through his WI DL as Jordy A. JAVIER LAUREANO, and asked him if the camera was working, which JAVIER LAUREANO yelled "You all fucking suck at doing your job." P.O. MUNOZ than asked JAVIER LAUREANO for his name and identification. JAVIER LAUREANO yelled "Fuck you and I don't have no name, I am not legal" and walked away from P.O. MUNOZ back in the bar. P.O. MUNOZ followed JAVIER LAUREANO into the bar and asked him again for his name and identifiaction, so P.O. MUNOZ could use his name in the incident report. JAVIER LAUREANO again yelled laudly, "Fuck you" and walked behind the bar. P.O. MUNOZ followed him and informed him if he did not provide him with the information he was going to be arrested. JAVIER LAUREANO stated he had no name, P.O. MUNOZ grabbed JAVIER LAUREANO'S left wrist in an attempt to escort him outside to detain him. JAVIER LAUREANO pulled away from P.O. MUNOZ'S grasp and placed his right hand on a bulge, which was located on the waistline of his right side. JAVIER LAUREANO got into a stance, where he was squared off with P.O. MUNOZ to unholster the item, which was later confirmed to be his concealed Ruger P95 9MM Semi-automatic firearm. P.O. MUNOZ grabbed both of JAVIER LAUREANO'S arms, where JAVIER LAUREANO began to resist arrest by jerking his arms and body left and right. P.O. MUNOZ was able to get a hold of both arms, placed them in the small of his back and placed handcuffs on JAVIER LAUREANO. P.O. MUNOZ seized the firearm, from the right side of JAVIER LAUREANO'S waistline.

In the rear of the marked patrol vehicle, JAVIER LAUREANO stated that he only resisted P.O. MUNOZ and yelled at him because he thought P.O. MUNOZ was a security guard, he stated that he did not know P.O. MUNOZ was a Police Officier. JAVIER LAUREANO was transported to District Two for booking. In the booking room JAVIER LAUREANO did possess a concealed weapons permit in his wallet.

The investigation revealed that the Quisquella Bar has multiple cameras, but they are not functional.

The Licensee Agent Deine DE LA ROSA was cooperative during the investigation.

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- 'a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

I would like to submit that there are already a number of businesses selling liquor within a small radius. I patronize one of those places.

The proposed location, on busy National Avenue, is likely to present unwanted traffic and potential danger. My wife and I live less than a block away. The neighborhood is growing with families and apartment dwellers. There is no parking for customers at 530 W. National except for a few metered spaces on the street and the likelihood of more traffic stopping for alcohol does not portend a healthy situation. I think it behooves us to ask the police how many people are stopped in this area of National Avenue for speeding and other unlawful activities. I am not against the sale of alcohol in my neighborhood. The owners of the nearby nightclub Jinx have proved to be responsible and reliable neighbors, but I hasten to stress that they do not sell alcohol to all comers on a busy street largely inhabited by teenagers in transit and ballet dancers.

It is my impression that this store currently is mainly an outlet for high school students and bus patrons to buy snacks and eigarettes. Auto and truck traffic is already problematic without having who knows how big an uptick in people stopping to buy intoxicating substances from a shop owner who is a former felon who has reputedly been convicted of 1st degree reckless homicide, possession with intent to deliver and domestic violence. A liquor store at this address would have profoundly negative impact on the safety, health and welfare of our neighborhood for the following reasons based on my 12 year residency in a neighboring business current convenience store:

this

- There already is a substantial liquor store on First Street in a more approriate transit strip mall so one is not needed here.
- Being on a busy thoroughfare, National Avenue, would promote constant stopping in front by people with no ties to good behavior. As it is we have several bars and nightclubs in the immediate vicinity who in good faith struggle

to control the outpouring of drunks - we don't need to return to having them on our doorsteps with a bottle in a bag.

- The over 70 immediate residents here on National between 5th and 6th Streets don't need this, in fact the lack of breadth of food stuffs offered now in the convenience doesn't make it convenient other than for cigarettes.
- Currently the high school students from Bradley Tech High School comprise a large portion of partrons of this store for snacks. The bus stop which is nearly in front is one of the busiest transit points for these students.
 Mixing alcohol with candy is dangerous.
- I greatly appreciate efforts to create new and creative businesses like a blues club, Brenner Brewing, Mobcraft, Fuel, Hamberger Mary's, artists/architects studios - the list goes on. They add to the the richness of the area while putting alcohol in a well considered and well regulated role. They build ongoing relationships with their clients and take responsibility for their behavior.
- Drive by business is a problem in an area which is struggling with improving what ahs been a history climare of prostitution and drug dealing - problems which go hand-in-hand with easy alcohol on the streets.
- Many younger children and parents frequent the Milwaukee Ballet which is right here. The neighborhood values





The investigation revealed that the victim (part owner) had suffered a gunshot to his left hand from a patron of the club. The patron earlier in the night had an altercation with an employee of the bar but was allowed to stay in the bar and did so until close. The actor was captured on surveillance cameras returning to the bar after close and firing shots into the bar. The actor was identified and later taken into custody for Reckless Endangering Safety.




