On Saturday, November 12, 2022, I was assigned to work the Wisconsin WINS Youth Tobacco Prevention. Assisting in this assignment was Ricardo GARCIA W/M 09/30/06 of 5221 N. 46th St., and Victor VARGAS-DIAZ W/M 07/31/05 of 2406 S. 10th St. Neither GARCIA or VARGAS-DIAZ are of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 09:45A, GARCIA entered Lincoln Beer & Liquor, located at 2717 W. Lincoln Av. and purchased a pack of Swisher Sweet Cigars. GARCIA described the employee as a W/M wearing a blue hooded sweatshirt and grey hair. GRACIA stated the employee did not ask or check his identification.

I entered the store and identified the employee based on the description given. The employee was identified as: Kelly J. KRACHT W/M 12/23/73 of M1741 S. 44th St. KRACHT initially appeared confused and didn't appear to recall the sale, however, his wife who was working beside him reminded him of the sale. KRACHT then admitted to the sale and stated he didn't ask for ID.

Nicholson Ave., Cudahy, WI 53110 and Miliani J. DIAZ H/F 12/30/06 of 1729 S. 1st St. Milwaukee, WI 53204. NEWTON is 17 years old and not of legal age to purchase tobacco.

At approximately 3:40p.m., NEWTON entered Lincoln Beer & Liquor, located at 2717 W. Lincoln Av. and purchased a pack of Dutch Berry Fusion Cigars. NEWTON described the employee as a W/F with glasses wearing a green shirt. NEWTON stated the employee did check his ID, however, sold anyway.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
