
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Greg Lampley was a passenger in a City of Milwaukee vehicle that was parked on Appleton Avenue near the intersection with Keefe Avenue. The uninsured motorist, who was traveling westbound on Keefe Avenue, entered the intersection with Appleton Avenue then stopped without warning, causing another uninsured motorist who was traveling northbound on Appleton Avenue, to swerve and collide with the City vehicle causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist(s), there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Lampley, sustained injuries to his neck, left shoulder, and low back. The treating physician indicated the left shoulder and low back injuries are permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$68,005.67.
