1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) is the fiscal agent for a multi-jurisdictional traffic safety task force comprised of MPD, Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office (MCSO), and Marquette University Police Department (a new member this year). The task force is focused on decreasing traffic crashes and obtaining voluntary compliance with traffic regulations to decrease fatalities and serious injury collisions. This grant will fund a campaign targeting impaired driving enforcement. MPD will conduct enforcement activities in high traffic areas to decrease impaired driving including operating a motor vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant or controlled substance, excessive speed, and aggressive driving violations.

2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

Improved safety on city roadways is a priority for the Milwaukee Police Department and is a focus of the Traffic Safety Unit. TSU utilizes universal traffic safety approaches designed to create deterrence and change unlawful traffic behaviors.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

The total grant award of \$97,510.61 with a grantor funded amount of \$78,008.49 (80%) and a local in-kind match of \$19,502.12 (20%) will fund police officer overtime for deployments during enforcement periods through September 2026. The award breakdown includes MPD at \$53,008.49 MCSO at \$20,000.00 and Marquette University at \$5,000.
