Dear Council Members:

Attached please find a permissive resolution that grants the Friends of the Hank Aaron State Trail permission to construct and maintain a car stop shelter within a permanent limited easement for public enhancement at 2500 West Canal Street.

The Friends of the Hank Aaron State Trail is a non-profit organization working to improve and promote the Hank Aaron State Trail. Currently the organization is requesting permission to construct and maintain a car stop shelter within a permanent limited easement at 2500 West Canal Street. The City of Milwaukee acquired the subject permanent limited easement for the purpose of public enhancement and the attached permissive resolution grants the Friends of the Hank Aaron State Trail permission for the car stop shelter to occupy this easement.

We feel that the proposed car stop shelter constitutes a public enhancement intended for the subject permanent limited easement for public enhancement at 2500 West Canal Street. We have, therefore, prepared the attached permissive resolution, which, if adopted, will allow the Friends of Hank Aaron State Trail to construct and maintain a car stop shelter within said permanent limited easement for public enhancement subject to approval by the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works.
